Lesson 1: Signing On

When Jesus sent His disciples out on an important mission, one of the things He told them to do was-make friends. This week, we'll learn about making friends, and find out why having good friends and being a good friend, can both make a huge difference.

Lesson 2: Player 2

Have you ever felt like you were "Player 2"? Like someone else gets to make all the choices, and you just have to watch? Letting others be first can be tough, but Jesus gives us an even greater challenge-choose to put other people first. This week we'll discover what that looks like, with a story from Jesus Himself.

Lesson 3: Chatroom

Have you ever seen someone bring down a fun time with a bad attitude? Or have you seen someone turn a boring day into an awesome one because they had a great attitude? This week, we'll see how we can make a difference with the power of attitude.

Lesson 4: Side Quests

Have you ever talked to someone who was distracted? It probably felt like they weren't listening or even like they didn't care. This week, we'll see what happened when one of Jesus' friends got distracted and learn how we can show others we care by paying attention.

Lesson 5: Level Up

When your team is losing, would you rather have teammates who quit, or keep on trying? Teams have to keep on trying, of course! It's the same for good friends. When our friend's life gets tough, we can make a huge difference, just by being there for them.

Lesson 6: Muted

Is there someone it feels like you always disagree with? You barely see them, and you're already arguing. This week, we'll see what happened when one of Jesus' brothers completely ignored Him and see the power of understanding someone else's point of view.

Lesson 7: For the Team

Sometimes, even the best of friends disagree. This week, we'll see what happened when two friends named Paul and Barnabas had a big argument and learn how forgiveness can save our friendships.

Lesson 8: Endgame

What does a great friend do? This week, we'll see the greatest example of friendship ever, and learn how being friends with Jesus can change our lives.



(Roll when directed) Elevate Opener


Do This: During the song, encourage kids to find a place to sit, and let them know it's time to get started.

Team Time 14:00



This series that we're in is called "Multiplayer." If you've ever played a game with someone else, that was a "multiplayer" game. Our lives are kind of "multiplayer," too. There are other people we have to be around, work with, trust, and help. That can be challenging, though. Today we'll find out one way you can make every relationship you have better. What is it? You'll have to wait to find out. Right now, let's get moving with a game called "Common Ground."

Game Title Slide: Common Ground

Your group will make a circle on the floor with one person in the middle. Your leader will read that person a card that asks them something about themselves. If your answer is the same as theirs, you have to stand up, and find a new open place to sit in the circle. The last person to sit down has to be in the middle next. Got it?

Know This: Groups should be about 20 or more kids. If groups need to combine, or you are able to play this with all the kids together as a large group, that is ok, too.

Do This: Make sure each group leader has a set of cards.

You may join your groups now! Look for the flag with your grade written on it and go there. If you are in first grade, you will go to the white flag to meet your group leader.

Do This: Allow groups to get organized.


Do This: Allow them to play for 5-7 minutes, or until they are wrapping up.

Challenge Wheel Video




Find three people wearing your favorite color and give them each a high five! Ready, set, go!


Do This: Make sure each kid finds their group. Help group leaders if there is a need. Encourage kids as they work to answer the question.

Know This: This is a time for kids to search for answers in the Bible and see how they can use the Bible to investigate and better understand life. This time is designed for kids to interact and deepen their understanding. They won't get all the answers but allow them to question and discover as much as possible. Be ready to support group leaders in any way needed.

Do This: Give the groups a warning about one minute before this time is up.

Media: Part 2 9:00

Alright, you can come back to the middle and find a spot to sit. You've had the chance to think about what the Source team should do. We'll find out what happens to them in a minute, but first Rue has a story for us about a group of people who had really bad attitudes.



It's amazing how much our attitudes matter.

Application 5:00

That's what I want you to remember today.

A good friend has a good attitude.

A good friend has a good attitude. In group time, we saw how a bad attitude can make our lives more boring, more difficult, and less fun. Imagine someone who walks into every class at school and says, "This is boring." Or "I don't want to be here." Do you think they're going to enjoy school? No!

Do This: Take out a jug of "dirty" water. It should have <u>only one drop</u> of food coloring in it. Put the food coloring in ahead of time.

It's like this jug of dirty water. Just a little dirt or something else gross would make you not want to drink this. Like that, having a bad attitude affects our whole life. A bad attitude can make us feel upset, annoyed, and bored, no matter what happens to us. A good attitude, though, changes our lives like a filter.

Do This: Pour some of the water into a bottle with a filter on it.

Imagine if that person changed their attitude about school. The school is the same, but they choose to say "This can be fun," and "Learning is important." Do you think they'll

have a better time at school? Yes! Absolutely. You can't control your school, the people around you, or what happens to you, but you can control your attitude. You have the power to change it.



Like we saw in group time, a bad attitude can spoil anything. A teammate with a bad attitude ruins the game. A kid at school with a bad attitude makes it less fun. A bad attitude can make our families struggle. But a good attitude is even more powerful. It's like a filter for our lives.

Do This: Squeeze the bottled water into a clear cup. The bottle will filter the food coloring out. Only squeeze a little water into the cup, the more you squeeze, the more red dye might make it through.

What happened to this water when it went through the filter? It became clearer again! The filter gets rid of dirt, grime, and muck. When we filter all the things that happen to us, good or bad, through a good attitude, we'll see the world in a new way. Bad things will still happen, but a good attitude reminds us that those bad things don't define who we are. Only God can tell us who we are, because he made us. And He says you are so amazingly and wonderfully made. Nothing can change that.

A good attitude works like this filter for our lives. If someone says something mean to us, a bad attitude might cause us to get angry or fight, but a good attitude helps us say "I'm not going to let them ruin my day."

When we fail, a bad attitude might make us say "I give up," or "I can't do this." But a good attitude helps us say "I'll try again," or "I'm still learning, I'll ask for help."

Here's the amazing thing: Every one of us can choose what kind of attitude we're going to have, because God made us that way. When life is tough, when it's great, and when it's anything in-between, you can choose the attitude you have, whatever happens. You can control your attitude, and the better you can control your attitude, the more you'll be able to be a great friend and family member.

Keep on thinking about that, what kind of attitude do you usually have? How could you choose to have a better attitude? Before we finish up with a challenge from Rue, let's take some time to worship God.



Worship 8:00

"Worship" is what we call saying or showing how much we love God. We worship by singing here in Elevate, but when we talk to God, learn about Him, and live the way He wants us to, we could call those things worship, too.


