Lesson 1: Signing On

When Jesus sent His disciples out on an important mission, one of the things He told them to do was make friends. This week, we'll learn about making friends, and find out why having good friends and being a good friend, can both make a huge difference.

Lesson 2: Player 2

Have you ever felt like you were "Player 2"? Like someone else gets to make all the choices, and you just have to watch? Letting others be first can be tough, but Jesus gives us an even greater challenge—choose to put other people first. This week we'll discover what that looks like, with a story from Jesus Himself.

Lesson 3: Chatroom

Have you ever seen someone bring down a fun time with a bad attitude? Or have you seen someone turn a boring day into an awesome one because they had a great attitude? This week, we'll see how we can make a difference with the power of attitude.

Lesson 4: Side Quests

Have you ever talked to someone who was distracted? It probably felt like they weren't listening or even like they didn't care. This week, we'll see what happened when one of Jesus' friends got distracted and learn how we can show others we care by paying attention.

Lesson 5: Level Up

When your team is losing, would you rather have teammates who quit, or keep on trying? Teams have to keep on trying, of course! It's the same for good friends. When our friend's life gets tough, we can make a huge difference, just by being there for them.

Lesson 6: Muted

Is there someone it feels like you always disagree with? You barely see them, and you're already arguing. This week, we'll see what happened when one of Jesus' brothers completely ignored Him and see the power of understanding someone else's point of view.

Lesson 7: For the Team

Sometimes, even the best of friends disagree. This week, we'll see what happened when two friends named Paul and Barnabas had a big argument and learn how forgiveness can save our friendships.

Lesson 8: Endgame

What does a great friend do? This week, we'll see the greatest example of friendship ever, and learn how being friends with Jesus can change our lives.

Opening Song and Welcome

(Roll when directed) Elevate Opener

Do This: During the song, encourage kids to find a place to sit, and let them know it's time to get started.

Series Title Slide: Multiplayer and clear audio

This series that we're in is called "Multiplayer." If you've ever played a game with someone else, that was a "multiplayer" game. Our lives are kind of "multiplayer," too. There are other people we have to be around, work with, trust, and help. That's what we're talking about this series, how our friends and families make a difference in our lives, and how we can change their lives, too.

Right now, let's get moving with a game called "Blanketball."



Game Title Slide: Blanketball

In this activity, you will have to work with a group to play a game of volleyball! You'll be on a team trying to toss the ball into the other team's area. If it hits the ground in their area, your team gets a point! The catch is that you can only touch the ball with your blanket. You must catch the ball in the blanket, and toss it using the blanket, too. Your group leader will divide you into teams and show you where you will play.

Do This: Give the groups time to get together.

Know This: Each group should have four small blankets, and a mini volleyball court made out of three cones on the ground. Leaders should split the groups into two even teams and give each team two blankets to use. Kids must stand around the blankets, and all hold on to them. Their goal is to toss the ball over the line using their blankets. If the ball hits the ground on their side, the other team gets a point.

Know This: More blankets may be sent for bigger groups. Smaller groups may have everyone play this game against each other. Younger groups may simplify this game by having the kids attempt to toss the ball back and forth to each other using the blankets and seeing how many times in a row they can catch it.

Ready, set, go!

A good friend is there when life is tough.

A good friend is there when life is tough. That's a great lesson for all of us. If you're going through a tough time, get help from good friends. Your family, your close friends, and even the leaders here at church, would love to help you if something tough is going on in your life.

If you know someone who is going through tough stuff, choose to be there for them. You don't have to fix everything, just keep on being their friend. Spend time with them. Say hi to them, even if they're grumpy. Let them know they matter to you.

When we support each other, we can do so much more than we can alone. Here's an example of how this works.



Sequoia picture

This kind of tree is called a Sequoia. (Seh-koy-yah). These trees can live up to 3,000 years. The largest one is 379 feet tall. That's taller than the Statue of Liberty! Sequoias

can also be thirty-five feet wide. The trunk of that tree would take up almost this whole room.

We can learn something super important from these trees. People love to look at how tall they grow, but that wouldn't be possible without the roots.

Many trees have roots that go down super deep, that hold them in the ground. The sequoias roots are very shallow, though. They only go about ten feet down. Think about that, how can roots that are only ten feet deep, hold up a tree that is 396 feet tall? The answer is- they work together. Their roots grow super wide, up to a hundred feet across. They join with the roots of other trees, and all hold each other together. So when a storm comes, all of the sequoias hold each other up.

Who is holding you up? Who can you trust to be there when life gets tough?

Also, who are you holding up? Who could you be there for when their life gets tough? If one of those trees tried to grow on its own, it wouldn't get very far. They are the biggest trees in the world because they work together.

When we work together, we have the chance to change this world. We can help others who are struggling, and we can have others to trust when we're going through difficult things.

I don't mean you have to fix everyone else's problems. Being there for someone listening to someone and caring about them, even if they're having a rough time, or a bad day. It means sitting with someone when they feel sad. It also means choosing to talk to someone when you're going through something tough. You don't have to go through it alone.
