



Open with Play Time

Welcome each Kid-O into the room as they arrive. Help them find a toy or game to encourage engagement during play time.

__:20 **Music & Worship:** Pick a song

Have Kid-Os use scarves, ribbons, or instruments as you lead them in singing. Encourage the Kid-Os to use their hands, feet, and voices as they worship God!

__:25 **Group Time**

Follow the Group Time Guide on the next page.

__:35 **Coloring**

Hand out the Bible story coloring sheets and coloring utensils. Encourage the Kid-Os to color a picture to take home!

End with Play Time

Allow the Kid-Os to play or color until they are picked up. Before each Kid-O leaves match their name tag to the grown-up's security tag.



Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: None

1. Snack

Circle Up: Have all Kid-Os sit in one section of the room for story time.

Do This: Give kids hand sanitizer, then hand each of them a snack.

2. Bible Story: Isaiah's Hope

Do This: Read through the Bible Story at least one time. If Kid-Os are engaged, feel free to read it a second time.

3. Hands-On Option: Waiting Game

Do This: Have Kid-Os try to hold perfectly still for ten seconds! If they can do it, try to go to fifteen seconds, and even twenty! You could have them just sit or strike a pose and try to hold still.

The Point: All of us have to wait sometimes. Isaiah was waiting for Jesus, but he had hope because he knew that God was always with him. We can have hope because we know God loves us!

4. Prayer

Do This: Pray! "Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to have hope because of Jesus. Amen."
