Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: Instructions Sheet

1. Introductions and Snack

Circle Up: Have Kid-Os sit down in a circle as quickly as they can and give you a “thumbs up” when they are ready to listen. Encourage each Kid-O to say their name.

Do This: Give kids hand sanitizer, then hand each of them a snack.

2. Discussion Questions

- What’s one time you have to follow instructions or rules? (School, home, when playing games)
- What wise choice did David make in our Bible Adventure? (He followed God’s plan.)

Repeatable Phrases: “God has a plan for me.” “I can trust God.”

3. Hands-On Option

Do This: Read through the instructions sheet, and have kids follow each of the instructions! They will spin, jump, dance, and have fun! You may join them in each of the instructions.

Discuss: What are some of the instructions God gives us? (Be kind, forgive others, care about others, tell the truth, don’t steal.)

The Point: God has a great plan for you and for me! David knew God had a plan for him, so when God gave David instructions, David did his best to follow them. God gives us instructions too, like the ones we find in the Bible, to help us live the way He made us to. God’s instructions are super important.

4. Big Idea, Memory Verse, Stickers, and Prayer

Do This: Practice the Big Idea and Memory Verse with the kids.

Memory Verse: Isaiah 9:2- “The people who are now living in darkness will see a great light.”

Big Idea: I can follow God’s plan.

Do This: Give each kid a sticker. Encourage them to talk about what they learned with their grown-ups.

Do This: Pray! “Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to follow your plan. Amen.”
