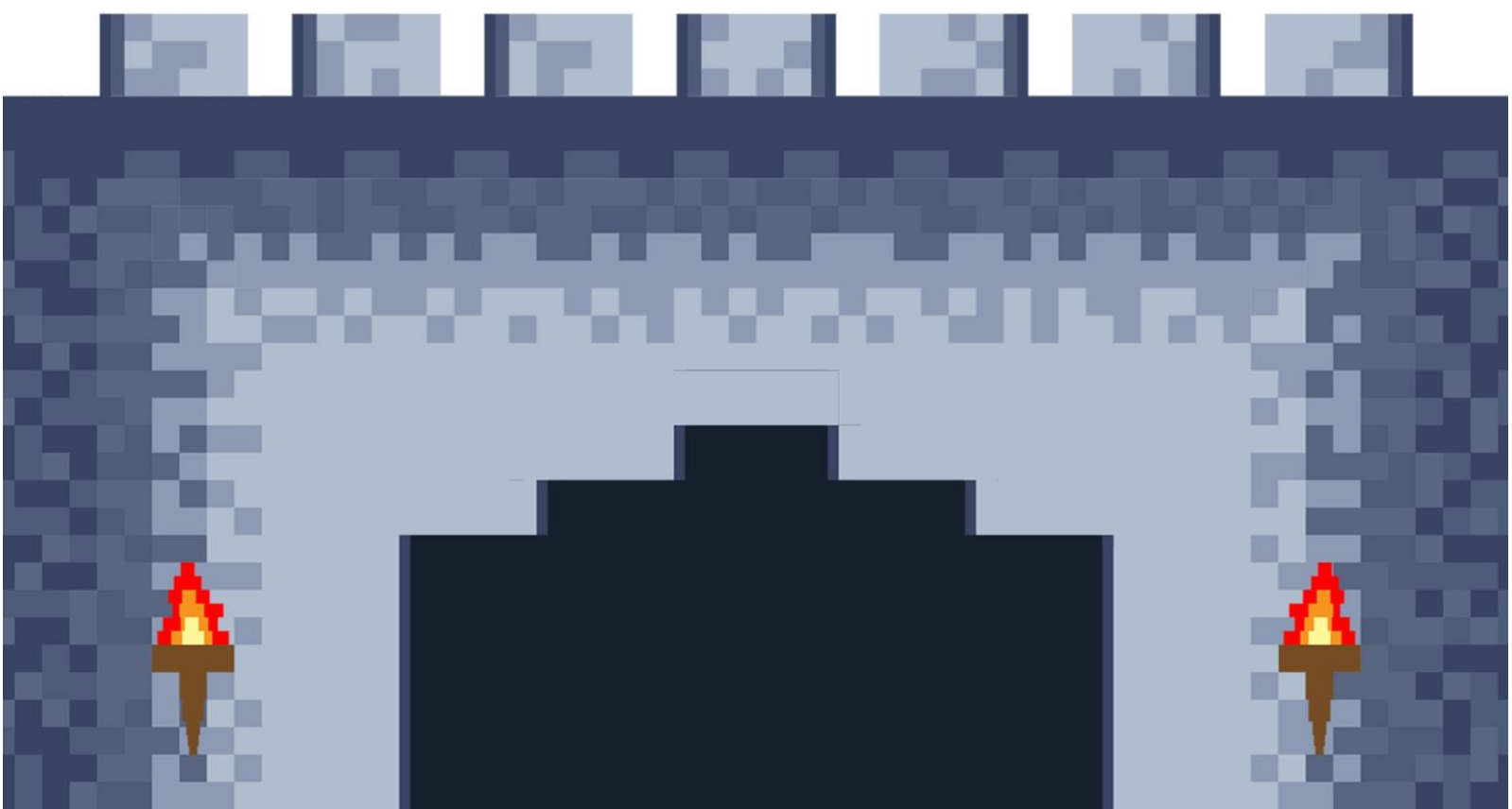

Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: Promise Cards

1. Getting Started

Ask: Who is someone you trust?

2. Discussion Questions

- What did Trixie say God has promised to give us? (Peace.) What do you think that could mean? (Whatever happens, God will be with us and help us.)
- What's a promise someone might make? (To keep a secret, to help with something.)
- Have you ever felt like someone broke a promise? How did you feel?

3. Hands-On Option

Look Up and Read: 2 Peter 1:3 and the first sentence of 2 Peter 1:4. God has made us some amazing promises!

Do This: Split the kids into groups and give each group a promise card. Have them look up the verse on the card and read it. If they need help looking up the verse, help them. Have each group answer the two following questions for their verse.

Discuss: When might it help us to remember this promise?

Discuss: What might it look like when God keeps this promise?

The Point: God has promised to be with us, love us, and give us peace and hope. God cares so much about you and will always keep his promises.

4. Wrap-Up and Prayer

Ask: What was the best part of your week? What was something tough that happened this week?

Do This: Pray with the kids. If they've mentioned things that would be good to talk to God about, you can talk about them in your prayer.
