# Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: Story Cards

## 1. Introductions and Snack

**Circle Up:** Have each Kid-O give you a high five and then sit down in a circle.

Encourage each Kid-O to say their name as you give them hand sanitizer.

**Do This:** Give kids hand sanitizer, then hand each of them a snack.

## 2. Discussion Questions

- What were the names of the two people in our Bible Adventure today? (Adam and Eve.)
- Why did God plan to send Jesus? (To show us that He loves us, no matter what).

*Repeatable Phrases: “God cares about me.” “I can tell God anything.”*

## 3. Hands-On Option

**Do This:** Read the story cards. After each story, have the kids say: “God loves you” to the character in that story. Then discuss the way the story says you could show love to that person.

**The Point:** God loves everyone on earth. We can tell everyone that God loves them, because it’s true. We can also always remember that God loves us, no matter what.

## 4. Big Idea, Memory Verse, Stickers, and Prayer

**Do This:** Practice the Big Idea and Memory Verse with the kids.

**Memory Verse:** Isaiah 9:2- “The people who are now living in darkness will see a great light.”

**Big Idea:** God loves me, no matter what.

**Do This:** Give each kid a sticker. Encourage them to talk about what they learned with their grown-ups.

**Do This:** Pray! “Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to share your love with others. Amen.”
