Introduction and Rules

Before we do any of that, there are three important things for you to remember. They're our three Kid-O-Deo rules!

Know This: This is a great opportunity to set the tone and expectations for your time together. Kids like to know what's expected of them too—it helps them feel safe and secure. You can make this section informative, helpful, and fun all at the same time!

Rule #1: When I'm talking you are listening!

Let's put on our listening ears and turn them way up! We'll also turn our voices way down, so that we can all listen super well.

Rule #2: Keep your hands and feet to yourself!

We want this to be a great place for all you leaders and Kid-Os, which means no poking, kicking, or bugging your neighbor. A good way to remember this rule is to: do a little clap and place your hands in your lap!

Rule #3: Stay in your spot!

You have a spot of your very own here in Kid-O-Deo, and it's right where you are sitting! It's important for us to stay in our spots, so that everyone can pay attention and have fun!

Big Idea 2:00

There's one really important thing we're talking about today, we call it our "Big Idea." Our Big Idea is super important for all of us to remember, so let's practice saying it together.

(Auto advance) Big Idea Slide: I can follow God's plan.

The Big Idea is, "I can follow God's plan." Can you repeat that after me? The Big Idea. THE BIG IDEA. I can follow, I CAN FOLLOW, God's plan. GOD'S PLAN. Alright, now let's say it all together!

Do This: Show Kid-Os the actions and have them practice the Big Idea with you three times. Use a different voice each time. **Voice ideas for this week: Quacking Duck, Buzzing Bee, and Gobbling Turkey.**

Know This: These are the Big Idea actions: (Make a rainbow motion with your hands) The Big Idea. (Walk in place) I can follow (Point upward) God's plan.

Awesome job practicing our Big Idea! You can all sit down.

While we're here today, listen closely for our Big Idea Bell! Whenever you hear this sound it means we need to say our Big Idea.

You can say it and still do the actions while sitting in your spot. Let's practice!

Bible Adventure

God has such an amazing plan, and you and I get to be part of it! We'll find out how by going on a Bible Adventure.



Bible Adventure Jingle

Do This: Show kids the Bible.

The Bible is the greatest book ever. The Bible is filled with stories from people who knew God and saw him do amazing things. Today, we get to hear a story about David, someone who chose to follow God's plan, even when it wasn't what David wanted.

Do This: Get the Bible storybook out and sit down in the chair.

This story you are going to hear comes from the Bible, but we use this storybook because the pictures help us imagine what it might have looked like back when the Bible was written. The pictures you see in here are the same as the ones on the screen. Let's get started!

Do This: Have kids help you "turn" the pages on the screen with an exaggerated arm wave.



Picture 1: King David

God had made David the king of the land of Israel. David was a good king, who loved and followed God. One day, David had an idea. He wanted to build an amazing building. I wonder what it was? A museum? A castle? A playground? Let's find out!



Picture 2: David thinks of the temple

David wanted to build a temple, a place for people to come and learn about God. It would be a big building, with lots of beautiful decorations. David wanted the temple to show everyone how important God was.



Picture 3: David and Nathan

David asked a wise person named Nathan about building the temple. At first, Nathan thought the temple was a good idea, but then God sent Nathan a message, too. God's plan was different from David's. There would be a temple, but David wasn't the right person to build it.



Picture 4: David prays

David chose to trust and follow God's plan, even though he was disappointed. David didn't get to build the temple, but God still wanted to make David an amazing promise. God promised David that one day, the greatest king ever would be born, and he would be from David's family. That king was God's Son, Jesus! Even when it was difficult, David knew he could always follow God's plan.

(Auto-advance) Memory Verse: Isaiah 9:2- The people who are now living in darkness will see a great light.

Our Memory Verses here in Kid-O-Deo come from the Bible.

Do This: Read the verse from the screen.

Have you ever had to walk through a dark place, like a cave or a hallway at night? What you need is a flashlight or lamp to follow. That's why the Bible here says Jesus is like a "light," someone who can lead us when life gets tough.

Do This: Practice the verse with the Kid-Os three times. You can start in your quiet/whisper voice and then get a little louder each time you practice.

Know This: The verse with actions goes like this: (Open your Bibles) Isaiah 9:2- (Hold your hands over your eyes) The people who are now living in darkness (hold your arms up in a Y position) will see a great light.
