(Roll when directed) Elevate Opener

Do This: During the song, encourage kids to find a place to sit, and let them know it's time to get started.

Series Title Slide: Christmas Party and clear audio

We celebrate something amazing at Christmas time every year. That's what we get to do here today: celebrate! We have so many fun things coming up, but the first thing to do is meet some of the other people we're at this party with! That means it's time for our challenge wheel!

(Auto Advance) Challenge Wheel Slide: Tell four people "Merry Christmas!" and learn their names.

Do This: Give kids time to talk with each other. When they seem to be wrapping up, or after about a minute, move on.

Christmas is such an exciting time. I think Rue and the Source Team are excited for Christmas, too. Let's see how they're celebrating!

The Source team is having a tough time. I wonder if they're going to try to figure it out on their own, or if they'll trust that God has a plan.

Application 1

4:00

Sometimes, our world can feel difficult to understand. Things happen that don't make sense. People are unkind. We do something we know is wrong, and wonder "Why did I do that?" We wonder how this whole big world got here, and even why we're here. It's like the world is so huge, and we can only see a little bit of it.

Do This: Take out an electric candle, and light it. **Do This**: Before the hour, make sure there is a volunteer in the back of the room who has the spotlight, and knows exactly when to light it (during Application 2).

Do This: Ahead of time, make sure windows and other sources of light that can't be turned off are blocked as much as possible, so as much light as possible is kept out of the room.

Turn off all lights in the room, so the candle is the only light.



Blacked Out Screen

It's like this candle in a very dark cave. We are trying to get through our lives following this tiny light; but walking without much light is dangerous. And, we'd have no idea what the cave was really like. We can see our tiny part of the cave, but we would have no idea how big it really is.

When we try to live without God, we live our lives that way. We're trying to find our own way, following our own tiny light, but we end up running into obstacles, failing, and losing our way. The thing is, every person in the world has lost their way because of something called sin.

You see, after God made this world, people began to disobey him. They didn't listen to God and did things they knew were wrong. All of us have done those things, too. Those wrong things, sometimes called "sin," separate us from God. They keep us from living the way He made us to. They keep us living like we're lost in the darkness. **Do This**: Walk around the stage with the candle.

Sometimes, we feel like following our own small light through life. We try to say "I don't need God," I can figure it out. We stumble around, we keep going down dead ends, because we're trusting things other than God to lead us. We trust ourselves, our friends, our grades, our talents, and so many other things to get us through life, but none of those things can show us what this world is really about.

It's like this verse from the book of Proverbs in the Bible says.

Do This: Read the verse from the screen.

When we do things we know are wrong, it's like we're living in the dark. So who can lead us through life? Who can show us why we were made? Let's check in with The Source team and Rue to find out.



The lights, aside from the screen and candle, should remain off.

Application 2

7:00

It was amazing to see Mr. Corbin come back, and I want to talk about what Rue shared for a moment, too. For thousands of years, people waited for God to send a leader, a king, someone to save them from all the wrong things they had done. Then, one night, a star appeared.

This star was shining above a town called Bethlehem, where God's Son Jesus had just been born. That night, angels appeared to some shepherds, and told them the greatest news of all; God has come to live with us, his name is Jesus! We can know God and have a relationship with him. The prophet Isaiah wrote about Jesus being born hundreds of years before it happened. This is a verse he wrote about when Jesus would come.

Do This: Read the verse from the screen.

When Jesus was born, the greatest light came into the world. He showed us who God is, how much God loves us, and that God made us for an amazing and special purpose. When we follow Him, He transforms our lives. We're not following our own tiny light anymore, but the greatest light of all: Jesus!

Do This: Have a volunteer in the back of the room (probably by the tech booth) turn on the spotlight. They should point it up at the top of the cross on stage, <u>not</u> into the audience or into anyone's eyes.

Know This: If your stage does not have a cross for any reason, the volunteer should point the spotlight above the center of the stage.

Know This: The spotlight is extremely bright and will hurt kids' eyes if pointed directly at them. Do not point it at anyone in the room. The volunteer should only point it at the top of the cross or above the stage, where no one can look directly into it.

Do This: Leave the spotlight and candle on until the lights are brought back up.

With this candle, we could only see a little bit of this room. With the spotlight, we can see so much more. This spotlight represents Jesus. With him leading us, we can always see and know that God made us, loves us, and forgives us. He shows us how to live the way God made us to. This light doesn't fix everything, or remove every problem and obstacle in our lives, but it helps us see the way around them. Like that, following God won't fix all our problems, but He will show us the way forward, and be with us no matter what.



You can bring the room lights up to the normal "teaching" setting at this point.

Maybe you know this already. You've heard the story of Jesus and decided to follow him. That's amazing! Jesus has changed your life and is still changing it every day. Christmas is a great time to share Jesus' story with others.

Maybe you have some questions. You're not sure about following God or Jesus yet. That is ok! Your questions are so important to God and to us. If you're feeling unsure, talk to me or one of the other adults in the room. We'd love to listen to you and get to know you.

Maybe, though, you're ready to follow the greatest light of all. Maybe today is the day you choose to follow Jesus, who lived, took our punishment, died, and came back to life to show how much God loves you, so you can follow his light. If you are ready to make the choice to follow Jesus for the first time, I'd love to talk to God with you.

In a moment, we're going to talk to God together. Everyone will close their eyes, to help us focus on what we're saying to God. If you want to choose to follow God with your whole life, you can repeat what I'm saying. You should know, though, it's not just saying the words that changes our lives. What's most important is that you really mean what you're telling God, that you believe Jesus died and came back to life and want to follow God with your whole life.

If you want to make that amazing decision, you can tell God right now! You can repeat this prayer after me.

Do This: Read the following prayer word-for-word, allowing kids time to repeat what you have said after each line.

God, thank you for loving me. I am sorry for doing things That I know are wrong. I believe that Jesus is your son. I believe that he died on the cross, Took my punishment, And came back to life, So that I can be forgiven. Jesus, I ask you now To be my Leader, Savior, And friend forever. I choose to follow you. In Jesus' name, amen.

Congratulations!

If you just made that decision for the first time, congratulations! I am so excited for you, because you just made the most important decision of your life. God changes our lives in so many amazing ways, following him is the greatest adventure of all! Speaking of that, we'd love to give you something that can help you get started following God.

Do This: Show kids the following Jesus book.

This book has some great ways for you to get started on your journey with God. Could I have everyone stand up?

Do This: Allow all the kids to stand up.

If you just decided to follow God for the first time, you can follow me! I want to celebrate with you and give you this helpful book. The rest of you get to do some singing to God. Ready? Remember, if you just decided to follow God, come with me!

Do This: Lead the first-time believers to a place where you can have the decision talk with them. Give them the Following Jesus book, and record their names so we know they made a decision!
