

# **Group Time Guide**

Supplies Needed: Beach ball

#### 1. Introductions and Snack

**Circle Up:** Have Kid-Os sit down in a circle as quickly as they can and give you a "thumbs up" when they are ready to listen. Encourage each Kid-O to say their name.

**Do This**: Give kids hand sanitizer, then hand each of them a snack.

#### 2. Discussion Questions

- What is the name of the prophet in our Bible Adventure today? (Micah.)
- What is the wise choice that Micah wanted people to make? (He wanted them to choose to follow God.)

Repeatable Phrases: "I can be wise." "God helps me be wise."

## 3. Hands-On Option

**Do This**: Hold the beach ball and give an example of an unwise choice. Pass the beach ball to the next Kid-O and have him/her give another example of an unwise choice. Go around the circle until everyone has had a chance to share an idea. Then, go around the circle again and have everyone share a wise choice we can make!

- -Examples of **unwise choices**: not following God, saying bad words, hitting someone, calling someone a mean name, being unkind, not obeying parents, not using respect.
- -Examples of **wise choices**: following God, being kind, loving others, being respectful, listening to grown-ups, using self-control, being gentle, being patient.

**The Point**: The wisest choice we can make is choosing to follow God! When we follow God, He will help us make many more wise choices.

### 4. Big Idea, Memory Verse, Stickers, and Prayer

**Do This**: Practice the Big Idea and Memory Verse with the kids.

**Memory Verse**: Habakkuk 3:18 - I will still be glad because of what the Lord has done. **Big Idea**: I can make the wise choice.

**Do This**: Give each kid a sticker. Encourage them to talk about what they learned with their grown-ups.

**Do This**: Pray! "Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help me to make wise choices. Amen.
