



# **Group Time Guide**

Supplies Needed: Coloring page of kid with a scraped knee, adhesive bandages

## **1. Introductions and Snack**

**Circle Up:** As you come into the room, have Kid-Os say "hi" to someone else in the circle as they sit down. Encourage each Kid-O to say their name.

Do This: Give kids hand sanitizer, then hand each of them a snack.

### 2. Discussion Questions

- Who are some people you care about?
- In our Bible Adventure, did the people in Edom care for their neighbors in Israel? (No, but God wants us to care for everyone.)
- What are some ways to show others that we care about them? (Possible answers: make someone a card or picture, say kind words to others, make someone a snack, share your toys.)

Repeatable Phrases: "God cares about me." "I can care like God does."

### 3. Hands-On Option

**Do This**: Hand each Kid-O a coloring picture of the boy with a scraped knee and an adhesive bandage. Have them color the picture and put the bandage on the boy's hurt knee.

The Point: God wants us to care for others!

### 4. Big Idea, Memory Verse, Stickers, and Prayer

**Do This**: Practice the Big Idea with the kids.

**Memory Verse**: Habakkuk 3:18 - I will still be glad because of what the Lord has done. God my Savior fills me with joy.

Big Idea: I can care about others.

**Do This**: Give each kid a sticker. Encourage them to talk about what they learned with their grown-ups.

**Do This**: Pray! "Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us remember to care for others. Amen."
