

Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: "I Can Trust" Coloring Sheets

1. Introductions and Snack

Circle Up: Have Kid-Os sit down in a circle as quickly as they can and give you a "thumbs up" when they are ready to listen. Encourage each Kid-O to say their name.

Do This: Give kids hand sanitizer, then hand each of them a snack.

2. Discussion Questions

- Who is someone you trust?
- In our Bible Adventure, who did Zechariah choose to trust? (God.) Repeatable Phrases: "God loves me." "God listens when I talk to Him."

3. Hands-On Option

Do This: Have Kid-Os color "I Can Trust" sheets. As kids are coloring, talk about the different things we can trust about God that are depicted on the various sections of the coloring sheet.

The Point: We can always trust in God!

4. Big Idea, Memory Verse, Stickers, and Prayer

Do This: Practice the Big Idea and Memory Verse with the kids.

Memory Verse: Habakkuk 3:18 - I will still be glad because of what the Lord has done. God my Savior fills me with joy.

Big Idea: I can always trust God.

Do This: Give each kid a sticker. Encourage them to talk about what they learned with their grown-ups.

Do This: Pray! "Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to trust you. Amen."
