

Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: None

1. Introductions and Snack

Circle Up: Have the Kid-Os put their hands in the middle, count to three and yell Kid-O-Deo! Then have everyone sit down. Encourage each Kid-O to say their name.

Do This: Give kids hand sanitizer, then hand each of them a snack.

2. Discussion Questions

- Who is someone that you follow? (Possible answers: a teacher, a parent, a friend.)
- In our Bible Adventure, who did Joel tell people to follow? (God.)
- Why does God want us to follow Him? (Possible answers: He loves us, He knows what's best for us.)

3. Hands-On Option

Do This: Play a game of "Follow the Leader." Allow Kid-Os to take turns being the leader, and encourage them to do fun moves like spinning, jumping on one foot, or acting like an animal while they are the leader.

The Point: We can follow the examples of other good leaders around us, but God is the best leader of all! We can always follow Him and know that He will help lead us to do what's right.

4. Big Idea, Memory Verse, Stickers, and Prayer

Do This: Practice the Big Idea and Memory Verse with the kids.

Memory Verse: Habakkuk 3:18 - I will still be glad because of what the Lord has done. **Big Idea**: I can follow God.

Do This: Give each kid a sticker. Encourage them to talk about what they learned with their grown-ups.

Do This: Pray! "Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Remind us to follow you. Amen."
