Open with Play Time

Welcome each Kid-O into the room as they arrive. Help them find a toy or game to encourage engagement during play time.

___:20 Music & Worship: Pick a song

Have Kid-Os use scarves, ribbons, or instruments as you lead them in singing. Encourage the Kid-Os to use their hands, feet, and voices as they worship God!

__:25 Group Time

Follow the Group Time Guide on the next page.

__:35 Coloring

Hand out the Bible story coloring sheets and coloring utensils. Encourage the Kid-Os to color a picture to take home!

End with Play Time

Allow the Kid-Os to play or color until they are picked up. Before each Kid-O leaves, give them a question sticker and match their name tag to the grown-up's security tag.

Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: Three scrolls

1. Snack

Circle Up: Have all Kid-Os sit in one section of the room for story time.

Do This: Give kids hand sanitizer, then hand each of them a snack.

2. Bible Story: The Missing Scrolls

Do This: Read through the Bible Story at least one time. If Kid-Os are engaged, feel free to read it a second time.

3. Hands-On Option: Scroll Searching

Do This: Prior to the activity time, hide the scrolls around the room keeping them somewhat visible from where the kids are sitting. Have Kid-Os search for the scrolls either by pointing them out, or if you have a smaller group, they could go out into the room to search. Play another round by having Kid-Os cover their eyes while you hide them again if time allows.

The Point: People learned about God many years ago by hearing stories and reading from scrolls. We can learn more about God today too by hearing stories from the Bible!

4. Stickers and Prayer

Do This: Give each kid a sticker.

Do This: Pray! "Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to learn more about you. Amen."
