

## **Open with Play Time**

Welcome each Kid-O into the room as they arrive. Help them find a toy or game to encourage engagement during play time.

## \_:20 Music & Worship: Pick a song

Have Kid-Os use scarves, ribbons, or instruments as you lead them in singing. Encourage the Kid-Os to use their hands, feet, and voices as they worship God!

## \_:25 Group Time

Follow the Group Time Guide on the next page.

## \_\_:35 Coloring

Hand out the Bible story coloring sheets and coloring utensils. Encourage the Kid-Os to color a picture to take home!

## **End with Play Time**

Allow the Kid-Os to play or color until they are picked up. Before each Kid-O leaves, give them a question sticker and match their name tag to the grown-up's security tag.



# **Group Time Guide**

**Supplies Needed: Building blocks** 

#### 1. Snack

**Circle Up:** Have all Kid-Os sit in one section of the room for story time.

Do This: Give kids hand sanitizer, then hand each of them a snack.

### 2. Bible Story: The New Temple

**Do This:** Read through the Bible Story at least one time. If Kid-Os are engaged, feel free to read it a second time.

### 3. Hands-On Option: Build Together

**Do This**: Have Kid-Os take turns stacking blocks as you work to "build the temple" together. Once it's built, you can knock it down and build it again.

**The Point**: God is the greatest of all, and people many years ago put Him first by building a temple for Him. We can all put God first by doing the things He wants us to do like loving Him and loving others!

### 4. Stickers and Prayer

**Do This**: Give each kid a sticker.

**Do This**: Pray! "Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to remember that you are great. Amen."
