# Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: Bible page, markers.

## 1. Discussion Questions

- What's the best part of summer?
- Josh and Beka asked the big question- what does God want us to do? How would you answer their question?

## 2. Hands-On Option

**Say This:** If you wanted to know what your parents wanted you to do, who would you ask? Your friend? Your dog? No! You'd ask your parents! So, if we want to know what God wants us to do, the best one to ask is- God! Probably the best way to find out what God wants us to do is to read what He says in the Bible. The Bible isn't always super easy to understand, though.

**Look Up and Read:** Hebrews 1:1-2. Point out the big chapter number and small verse numbers in the Bible. Take out the Bible verse page with these verses on it.

**Do This:** See if you can figure out what these verses are talking about! On your verse page, draw an arrow under action words, like "spoke." Draw a cloud by the words for "God," including the times the verse uses "He" to refer to God. Draw a cross by the words for Jesus, especially "His Son."

**Discuss:** What are these verses saying? (God used to tell us things through prophets. Now, though, he speaks to us through His Son, who is Jesus." Learning about Jesus is the best way to get to know God!)

**Say This:** Another fun way to learn from the Bible is by looking up the real places the Bible talks about! With an adult's help, you can look up pictures of the real places you read about in the Bible, and imagine what it was like to be there.

**The Point:** The Bible is exciting, because it tells us the true story of our world. Through it, you can learn more about God every day! If you're looking for a place to get started, you can pick up one of our Bible reading plans when you leave today.

## 3. Wrap-Up and Prayer

**Ask:** What's something you're excited about right now? What's something you would like God's help with?

**Do This:** Pray with the kids. If they've mentioned things that would be good to talk to God about, you can mention them in your prayer.
