



Open with Play Time

Welcome each Kid-O into the room as they arrive. Help them find a toy or game to encourage engagement during play time.

__:20 Music & Worship: Pick a song

Have Kid-Os use scarves, ribbons, or instruments as you lead them in singing. Encourage the Kid-Os to use their hands, feet, and voices as they worship God!

__:25 Group Time

Follow the Group Time Guide on the next page.

__:35 Coloring

Hand out the Bible story coloring sheets and coloring utensils. Encourage the Kid-Os to color a picture to take home!

End with Play Time

Allow the Kid-Os to play or color until they are picked up. Before each Kid-O leaves match their name tag to the grown-up's security tag.



Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: None

1. Snack

Circle Up: Have all Kid-Os sit in one section of the room for story time.

Do This: Give kids hand sanitizer, then hand each of them a snack.

2. Bible Story: The Church

Do This: Read through the Bible Story at least one time. If Kid-Os are engaged, feel free to read it a second time.

3. Hands-On Option: Act It Out

Say This: When people get together to learn about God, pray, and get to know each other, we call that the church! We are all at church right now. Every one of you is so important to God, and to this church. Can you copy me as I pretend to do some of the things the church does?

Do This: Act out the following things that the church does. The church prays- fold your hands and bow your head. The church helps others- give each other a high-five! The church sings about God- sing “La la la!” The church learns together- pretend you’re reading a book.

The Point: The church does so many things, and every one of you can be part of it. I’m so glad every one of you is here.

4. Prayer

Do This: Pray! “Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to be part of the church. Amen.”
