



Open with Play Time

Welcome each Kid-O into the room as they arrive. Help them find a toy or game to encourage engagement during play time.

__:20 Music & Worship: Pick a song

Have Kid-Os use scarves, ribbons, or instruments as you lead them in singing. Encourage the Kid-Os to use their hands, feet, and voices as they worship God!

__:25 Group Time

Follow the Group Time Guide on the next page.

__:35 Coloring

Hand out the Bible story coloring sheets and coloring utensils. Encourage the Kid-Os to color a picture to take home!

End with Play Time

Allow the Kid-Os to play or color until they are picked up. Before each Kid-O leaves match their name tag to the grown-up's security tag.



Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: None

1. Snack

Circle Up: Have all Kid-Os sit in one section of the room for story time.

Do This: Give kids hand sanitizer, then hand each of them a snack.

2. Bible Story: Saul is Forgiveness

Do This: Read through the Bible Story at least one time. If Kid-Os are engaged, feel free to read it a second time.

3. Hands-On Option: I Can Forgive

Do This: Read each of the following examples and have Kid-Os repeat the phrase “I forgive you” to each one.

- When someone says mean words to me, I can say...
- When someone gets mad at me, but then says they’re sorry, I can say...
- When someone breaks one of my toys, and says they’re sorry, I can say...
- When someone doesn’t listen to me, I can say...

The Point: We can all forgive others, even when we feel mad at them. When we do, it’s important to tell them “I forgive you.”

4. Prayer

Do This: Pray! “Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to forgive others. Amen.”
