



Open with Play Time

Welcome each Kid-O into the room as they arrive. Help them find a toy or game to encourage engagement during play time.

__:20 Music & Worship: Pick a song

Have Kid-Os use scarves, ribbons, or instruments as you lead them in singing. Encourage the Kid-Os to use their hands, feet, and voices as they worship God!

__:25 Group Time

Follow the Group Time Guide on the next page.

__:35 Coloring

Hand out the Bible story coloring sheets and coloring utensils. Encourage the Kid-Os to color a picture to take home!

End with Play Time

Allow the Kid-Os to play or color until they are picked up. Before each Kid-O leaves match their name tag to the grown-up's security tag.



Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: None

1. Snack

Circle Up: Have all Kid-Os sit in one section of the room for story time.

Do This: Give kids hand sanitizer, then hand each of them a snack.

2. Bible Story: Paul goes to Rome

Do This: Read through the Bible Story at least one time. If Kid-Os are engaged, feel free to read it a second time.

3. Hands-On Option: Act it Out!

Say This: Let's act out that story we just read!

Do This: Act out the story! Follow the steps below.

Part One: Paul is sailing on a boat. Can you shade your eyes with your hand, and say "All aboard"? Even though Paul was going to a new place on this boat, he trusted that God was with him.

Part Two: A huge storm comes up! Can you say "Whoosh" for the wind and "Boom!" for the thunder? Whoosh! Boom! Even in a big storm, Paul trusted that God was in control.

Part Three: The ship sinks! Can you pretend to swim around? Paul trusted God had a plan, even when he felt afraid.

Part Four: Paul made it to Rome! Can you jump up and cheer!

The Point: God was always there with Paul, and He is always with you, too!

4. Prayer

Do This: Pray! "Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to always trust you. Amen."
