

Introduction and Rules

Know This: This is a great opportunity to set the tone and expectations for your time together. Kids like to know what's expected of them too—it helps them feel safe and secure. You can make this section informative, helpful, and fun all at the same time!

Rule #1: When I'm talking you are listening!

Let's put on our listening ears and turn them way up! We'll also turn our voices way down, so that we can all listen super well.

Rule #2: Keep your hands and feet to yourself!

We want this to be a great place for all you leaders and Kid-Os, which means no poking, kicking, or bugging your neighbor. A good way to remember this rule is to: do a little clap and place your hands in your lap!

Rule #3: Stay in your spot!

You have a spot of your very own here in Kid-O-Deo, and it's right where you are sitting! It's important for us to stay in our spots, so that everyone can pay attention and have fun!

(Auto advance) Series Title Slide: Shine

Big Idea 2:00

I love singing with you, Kid-Os! You can sit down. We're in a series today called "Shine." When you light a candle or turn on a lightbulb, you can see it from very far away. When lights shine, they help us see all the things around us. We can show others how wonderful God is. Sometimes, we call that "shining" for him! That's what this series is all about.

We call the super important idea we're talking about today our "Big Idea." Let's practice saying today's big idea together!

(Auto advance) Big Idea Slide: I can always trust God.

The Big Idea is, "I can always trust God." Can you repeat that after me? I can always, I CAN ALWAYS, trust God. TRUST GOD.

Do This: Show Kid-Os the actions and have them practice the Big Idea with you three times. Use a different voice each time. **Voice ideas for this week: Slow turtle, floating astronaut, fast rollercoaster.**

Know This: These are the Big Idea actions: (Place your hands in front of your face, palms out, then move them down in a rainbow motion) The Big Idea. (Point to self) I can always (fold hands together) trust God.

Awesome job practicing our Big Idea! You can all sit down.

That Big Idea is so important, we're going to say it several times today. Whenever you hear this sound, it's time to say our big idea!

Big Idea Light and Ding

You can say it and still do the actions while sitting in your spot. Let's practice!

Let's say the Big Idea together. THE BIG IDEA. I CAN ALWAYS TRUST GOD. Great job, Kid-Os!

Series Title Slide: Shine

Bible Adventure

I'm so excited to learn more about how we can shine for God! Next we get to learn more by going on a Bible Adventure.



Bible Adventure Jingle

Do This: Show kids the Bible.

The Bible is the greatest book ever. It's full of words from God, and there are lots of true stories about people who loved God in the Bible too! Today, we get to read a story about someone who trusted God, even when they probably felt afraid.

Do This: Get the Bible storybook out and sit down in the chair.

This story you are going to hear comes from the Bible, but we use this storybook because the pictures help us imagine what it might have looked like back when the Bible was written. The pictures you see in here are the same as the ones on the screen. Let's get started!

Do This: Have kids help you "turn" the pages on the screen with an exaggerated arm wave.



Picture 1: Paul on a big boat

Paul wanted to tell everyone he could about Jesus. He had even asked to talk to the ruler of the whole land, so that Paul could tell him about Jesus. That's why Paul was on a ship, headed for a big city called Rome.



Picture 2: Boat in a storm

Suddenly, the boat was caught in a huge storm! It rained for days and days! Everyone on the ship was afraid the boat would sink. Paul talked to God, though, and God told him that everyone would be ok. Paul believed what God said and told everyone else that they were going to be ok.




Picture 3: The ship sinks.

After 14 days, they hit some sand under the water, and the ship was stuck! Then things got even worse. Huge waves started to break the ship, and everyone had to swim for the shore. Just like God had told Paul, though, everyone made it safely to shore.



Picture 4: Paul in Rome

No matter what happened, Paul trusted God. He believed what God said and followed Him no matter what. Paul showed everyone else that they could always trust God, too. When others saw how much Paul believed in God, many of them decided to follow God, too. We can believe what God says and trust Him today, too!

(Auto-advance) Memory Verse: Acts 1:8- "You will even tell other people about me from one end of the earth to the other."

Our Memory Verses come from the Bible. This one is something Jesus told his followers to do.

Do This: Read the verse from the screen.

Everyone needs to know Jesus' story! Part of trusting God and his son Jesus is following the things they tell us to do, like sharing Jesus' story with others! Let's say that verse together.

Do This: Practice the verse with the Kid-Os three times. You can start in your quiet/whisper voice and then get a little louder each time you practice.

Know This: The verse with actions goes like this: (Open your Bibles) Acts 1:8. (Point out) You will even (cup hands around mouth) tell other people (point up) about me (Stretch left hand out wide) from one end of the earth (stretch right hand out wide) to the other.

Super job practicing your Memory Verse, Kid-Os!

See you later, [name]. Every one of us can serve others to show them how much God loves them. You can serve your brothers, sisters, friends, and even your grown-ups!

Kid-O-Whampus


