Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: Doing Right story cards

1. Introductions

Circle Up: As you come into the room, have Kid-Os say “hi” to someone else in the circle as they sit down. Encourage each Kid-O to say their name.

2. Discussion Questions

- Thanksgiving is coming up this week! What is something you’re thankful for?
- What did God tell Zechariah that Zechariah didn’t believe at first? (That he and his wife Elizabeth would have a baby.)

3. Hands-On Option

Do This: Read each of the “Doing Right” story cards. Have Kid-Os give you a thumbs-up if the person in the story is choosing to do what’s right, and a thumbs-down if they don’t choose to do what’s right.

The Point: We can choose to do what God says is right every day. He loves us no matter what, and will always help us, too!

4. Big Idea, Memory Verse, and Prayer

Do This: Practice the Memory Verse and the Big Idea with the kids.

Memory Verse: Luke 2:10-11- “I bring you good news. It will bring great joy for all the people. Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you. He is the Messiah, the Lord.”

Big Idea: I can do what God says is right.

Do This: Encourage them to talk about what they learned with their grown-ups.

Do This: Pray! “Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to trust what you say. Amen.”
