

Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: "Truth or Lie" cards

1. Introductions

Circle Up: Have the Kid-Os wave at each other and then sit down in a circle. Encourage each Kid-O to say their name as you give them hand sanitizer.

2. Discussion Questions

- Who believed what God said was true in our Bible Adventure? (Joshua and Caleb)
- How do we learn more about what God says? (Read the Bible, go to church, talk to God.)

3. Hands-On Option

Do This: Read the statement on the "Truth or Lie" card. If the Kid-Os think the statement is true, they should stand up. If they think the statement is a lie, they should sit down.

Say This: Sometimes it can be hard to know the difference between truth and lies. That's why it's so important to know what God says. What God says is always true.

The Point: The Belt of Truth reminds us to believe what God says is true.

4. Big Idea, Memory Verse, and Prayer

Do This: Practice the Big Idea and Memory Verse with the kids.

Memory Verse: Ephesians 6:10 – "Finally, let the Lord make you strong. Depend on His mighty power."

Big Idea: I can believe what God says is true.

Do This: Encourage kids to talk about what they learned with their grown-ups.

Do This: Pray! "Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to believe what you say is true. Amen."
