



Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: "What's Right?" stories

1. Introductions

Circle Up: As you come into the room, have Kid-Os say "hi" to someone else in the circle as they sit down. Encourage each Kid-O to say their name.

2. Discussion Questions

- Why was Daniel thrown into the lions' den? (He would only worship God and not the king.)
- How do we learn what God says is right? (Read the Bible, talk to God, go to church)

3. Hands-On Option

Do This: Read the "What's Right?" stories. Each story will end with two options and kids will choose which one they think God says is right.

Say This: Sometimes it can be difficult to do the things God says are right. But doing what God says will protect us from wrong choices and help us to live the best way.

The Point: The Armor of Godliness reminds us to do the things that God says are right.

4. Big Idea, Memory Verse, and Prayer

Do This: Practice the Memory Verse and the Big Idea with the kids.

Memory Verse: Ephesians 6:10 – "Finally, let the Lord make you strong. Depend on His mighty power."

Big Idea: I can do what God says is right.

Do This: Encourage kids to talk about what they learned with their grown-ups. **Do This**: Pray! "Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to do the things you say are right. Amen."
