# **Open with Play Time**

Welcome each Kid-O into the room as they arrive. Help them find a toy or game to encourage engagement during play time.

### **\_\_:20** Music & Worship: Pick a song

Have Kid-Os use scarves, ribbons, or instruments as you lead them in singing. Encourage the Kid-Os to use their hands, feet, and voices as they worship God!

# \_\_:25 Group Time

Follow the Group Time Guide on the next page.

# \_\_:35 Coloring

Hand out the Bible story coloring sheets and coloring utensils. Encourage the Kid-Os to color a picture to take home!

# **End with Play Time**

Allow the Kid-Os to play or color until they are picked up. Before each Kid-O leaves match their name tag to the grown-up's security tag.

# **Group Time Guide**

Supplies Needed: None

## 1. Circle Up

**Circle Up:** Have all Kid-Os sit in one section of the room for story time.

### 2. Bible Story: Saul/Paul – Acts

**Do This:** Read through the Bible Story at least one time. If Kid-Os are engaged, feel free to read it a second time.

## 3. Hands-On Option: Go and Tell

**Say This:** Today, we're learning about a piece of God's armor called the Good News Shoes. It reminds us to tell other people about Jesus, just like Paul did.

**Do This**: Have Kid-Os pretend to put on their special Good News Shoes to help them go and tell others about Jesus. Then play a game called "Go and Tell". Have Kid-Os stand up and listen for the leader to tell them how to move. Model for the kids so they know what to do. Try these different actions – run in place, jump, march, hop like a frog, and spin around. After each action, have Kid-Os repeat this phrase after you – "Jesus loves you!"

**The Point**: We can all go and tell other people that Jesus loves them.

# 4. Prayer

**Do This**: Pray! "Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to tell people about you. Amen.
