Open with Play Time

Welcome each Kid-O into the room as they arrive. Help them find a toy or game to encourage engagement during play time.

__:20 Music & Worship: Pick a song

Have Kid-Os use scarves, ribbons, or instruments as you lead them in singing. Encourage the Kid-Os to use their hands, feet, and voices as they worship God!

__:25 Group Time

Follow the Group Time Guide on next page.

__:35 Coloring

Hand out the Bible story coloring sheets and coloring utensils. Encourage the Kid-Os to color a picture to take home!

End with Play Time

Allow the Kid-Os to play or color until they are picked up. Before each Kid-O leaves, give them a question sticker and match their name tag to the grown-up's security tag.

Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: A doll

1. Snack

Circle Up: Have all Kid-O's sit in one section of the room for story time.

Do This: Give kids hand sanitizer, then hand each of them a snack.

2. Bible Story: God makes people

Do This: Read through the Bible Story at least one time. If Kid-O's are engaged, feel free to read it a second time.

3. Hands-On Option: Eye Color

Do This: Show Kid-Os the doll, and ask them what color the doll's eyes are. After they see it, ask them what color their eyes are. We need help to find our own eye color! Have them look at another Kid-Os eyes and tell them what color they are. This will build cooperation, and challenge Kid-Os to answer a question about another person.

The Point: Did you know that God knows everything about you? He knows youre eye color, how many hairs are on your head, and He knows the things you like and don't like. He has such a special plan for you, and loves you very much.

4. Stickers, and Prayer

Do This: Give each kid a sticker.

Do This: Pray! "Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Thank you for making us. Amen."
