



## **Open with Play Time**

Welcome each Kid-O into the room as they arrive. Help them find a toy or game to encourage engagement during play time.

### **\_\_:20 Music & Worship: Pick a song**

Have Kid-Os use scarves, ribbons, or instruments as you lead them in singing. Encourage the Kid-Os to use their hands, feet, and voices as they worship God!

### **\_\_:25 Group Time**

Follow the Group Time Guide on next page.

### **\_\_:35 Coloring**

Hand out the Bible story coloring sheets and coloring utensils. Encourage the Kid-Os to color a picture to take home!

## **End with Play Time**

Allow the Kid-Os to play or color until they are picked up. Before each Kid-O leaves, give them a question sticker and match their name tag to the grown-up's security tag.



# Group Time Guide

**Supplies Needed: None**

## 1. Snack

**Circle Up:** Have all Kid-O's sit in one section of the room for story time.

**Do This:** Give kids hand sanitizer, then hand each of them a snack.

## 2. Bible Story: Daniel in the Lion's Den

**Do This:** Read through the Bible Story at least one time. If Kid-O's are engaged, feel free to read it a second time.

## 3. Hands-On Option: Big Noise

**Do This:** Tell Kid-Os that they are going to make big and small noises. When your arms are spread wide, that's the time for a big noise! If your arms are close together, we should get quiet and make a small noise. This will develop kids' ability to focus and follow instructions.

**The Point:** Whether we talk loudly, quietly, or even just think words in our minds, God always knows what we say. He always listens to you because your voice is so important to Him.

## 4. Stickers, and Prayer

**Do This:** Give each kid a sticker.

**Do This:** Pray! "Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Thank you for listening to us. Amen."
