



Open with Play Time

Welcome each Kid-O into the room as they arrive. Help them find a toy or game to encourage engagement during play time.

__:20 Music & Worship: Pick a song

Have Kid-Os use scarves, ribbons, or instruments as you lead them in singing. Encourage the Kid-Os to use their hands, feet, and voices as they worship God!

__:25 Group Time

Follow the Group Time Guide on next page.

__:35 Coloring

Hand out the Bible story coloring sheets and coloring utensils. Encourage the Kid-Os to color a picture to take home!

End with Play Time

Allow the Kid-Os to play or color until they are picked up. Before each Kid-O leaves, give them a question sticker and match their name tag to the grown-up's security tag.



Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: None

1. Snack

Circle Up: Have all Kid-Os sit in one section of the room for story time.

Do This: Give kids hand sanitizer, then hand each of them a snack.

2. Bible Story: Noah's Ark

Do This: Read through the Bible Story at least one time. If Kid-Os are engaged, feel free to read it a second time.

3. Hands-On Option: Listen Up

Do This: Have one of the room leaders make one animal noise at a time. Animal noises: moo (cow), woof (dog), baa (sheep), meow (cat), quack (duck), neigh (horse). Leaders can start out very quietly and get louder. Have Kid-Os listen closely and say what animal they hear. Then have everyone act like that animal together!

The Point: We can listen to God. He tells us to love others and say kind words. He also wants us to obey our grown-ups. He also tells us that He loves and cares about us so much! We can listen to God and grow in our friendship with Him.

4. Stickers and Prayer

Do This: Give each kid a sticker.

Do This: Pray! "Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us listen to you. Amen."
