Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: Set of “Community” pages

1. Getting Started

Encourage kids to talk about this question: What’s a time you had to work together with others? (You could think of a group project or a team you’re on.)

2. Discussion Questions

- Do you think Trixie joining this group is a good idea? Why or why not?
- What are some things that make a community or group “good”? (They help each other, they are kind, they care about each other.)
- What’s great about working together with others? What can be tough about working together with others?

3. Hands-On Option

Look Up and Read: Romans 12:15-16. These verses are about being good friends and neighbors to others.

Discuss: Who is in our “community” today? Who are the people we see regularly? (You could talk about family, neighbors, friends at school, teams, and church.)

Do This: Look at each of the “community” pages and talk about the ways that part of your community makes a difference in your life. Discuss ways you could make an impact with each of the groups listed.

The Point: It takes all of us working together to make a difference in our families, schools, communities, and our world. God has given us a mission to change the world together. When we serve, encourage others, and join people doing great things in our communities, we’re showing that we trust and love God.

4. Wrap-Up and Prayer

Ask: What was the best part of your week? Is there a relationship, like a friend or family member, that you would like God’s help with this week?

Do This: Pray with the kids.
