Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: Gift Page

1. Getting Started

Ask kids: If you started working at any job you wanted to tomorrow, what would you want to do?

2. Discussion Questions

- What are some different “strengths” the people on the Source team have? What are they good at? (Could mention that Gabby is good at writing, Jesse can train people in gym, Bowie loves helping people.)
- What are some different things people can be really good at? (A sport, music, listening, serving.)
- Who is someone you know that is really good at each of those things?

3. Hands-On Option

Look Up and Read: Romans 12:6-8. These verses talk about some of the different “gifts” God gives to people.

Say This: Those verses said God gives each of us “gifts.” Those aren’t gifts like Christmas or birthday gifts. The gifts God gives us are abilities, things we are really good at, especially things that help us show others God’s love.

Do This: Read the “Gift page” and answer the questions. You will think about someone you know who is good at each of the gifts God gives, and ways you could use that gift in your own lives. (Examples are provided.)

The Point: There are so many people who use these gifts to care about us and help us, even if we don’t notice them. None of us are good at all of these things, but whatever our gifts are, they are important to God. When we use the gifts God gives us to share his love, we can change the world around us for good!

4. Wrap-Up and Prayer

Ask: What’s something you’re excited about right now? What’s something you would like God’s help on?

Do This: Pray with the kids.
