Lesson 1: The Master Artist

On Easter, we celebrate the most amazing thing the world has ever seen. Jesus, God's Son, died and came back to life! Since that day, the world has never been the same. This week, we'll celebrate Easter and find out why what Jesus did changed everything, for everyone.

Lesson 2: The Canvas

Jesus changed everything, but only a few people knew about it. Fortunately, God had a plan to share Jesus' story with the whole world. To make that plan happen, Jesus' followers started the church. Find out how the church began, and why you're an important part of it, this week!

Lesson 3: Guest Artist

When God needed someone to share Jesus' story to the world, he chose a man named Saul. Most Christians thought Saul was just mean and unkind, and maybe even thought he would never change. God saw something amazing in Saul, though, and gave him a second chance.

Lesson 4: Every Hue

Who can follow God? Is Jesus' story only for certain people, or is it for everyone? This week, we'll find out how Peter discovered God's love really is for everyone.

Lesson 5: Finding Your Style

Sharing Jesus' story doesn't always mean talking in front of big groups of people. This week, we'll meet a woman named Lydia, who shared God's love by welcoming and serving others.

Lesson 6: Artist's Block

Sometimes following God feels like the greatest thing ever, but at other times it can feel extremely difficult. After being captured, sent away from his home, and then shipwrecked, Paul could have felt like giving up. What he did instead was a great example of how God can help us do tough things.

Series Title Slide: Technicolor and clear audio

We're in a series called "Technicolor." God is making something amazing happen in our world, like an incredible work of art. Every one of us gets to be part of that! In this series, we're looking at how God started changing our world, and how God can turn each of our lives into a masterpiece.

Let's get started with a game called "What do you notice?"

Game Title Slide: "What do you notice?"

Here is how the game works. In just a minute, you will get together by your group flag and sit in a circle. One person will be chosen to leave the group for a minute while the rest of the group all changes one thing. For example, maybe everyone in the group takes off one shoe. Your group leader will let you know what you are going to change each time. When everyone is ready, the person guessing will turn around and try to notice what changed in the group. They will get 3 guesses. This can be tricky! Let's give it a try! Head over to your flag and get into a circle!

Know This: This game can be turned into a competition, where two kids leave the group and then the first one to notice the difference is the winner for that round. **Do this:** Walk around to the different groups to encourage them or help a group leader if

Here's what I want you to remember today.

God's love is for everyone.

God's love is for everyone. It is not based on where you live, what you look like, or who your friends are. God's love is not just for kids who get good grades or the kids who seem like they do all the right things. God loves every single person, including you!

Peter learned this when God told him to go to Cornelius' house. Peter thought that God's love was only for people who were similar to him. Peter hadn't even thought that God would love someone like Cornelius, but God showed him that he doesn't have favorites.

Take a look at this picture of a tree.

When you first look at it, it just looks like a normal tree. But when you look a little closer you see it differently. You can see two people's faces there too.

Do This: Give kids 10-20 seconds to see the illusion, it may take some of them a bit to figure it out. Encourage them to look for it but move on fairly quickly as well.

It is something that you might not notice at first. Sometimes there are people in our lives that we don't notice right away as people who we could share God's love with, but God sees things differently.

Maybe for you, there is a kid at school who doesn't have many friends and often sits by themselves.

You could be the one to notice them and tell them all about God's love. You could sit next to them at lunch or invite them to hang out with you during recess. Or maybe you are the person who sits alone. God sees you and he loves you so much.

Think about the people in your neighborhood.

Is there someone that you have never thought to invite to church because they seem so different from you? God wants us to share his love with them.

Or maybe you know someone at school or on a sports team who isn't very nice.

Photo of unkind boy.

You wonder how God could love them. You could be the one to show them kindness. God wants us to share his love with them too because every person matters to God!

God's love is for everyone, including each one of you and including people we might not expect.
