Lesson 1: The Master Artist

Do This: During the song, encourage kids to find a place to sit, and let them know it's time to get started.


Welcome everyone! I'm so glad you're all here! Come on up and find a place to sit.

Team Time 14:00



We're in an awesome series called "Technicolor." God is making something amazing happen in our world, like an incredible work of art. Every one of us gets to be part of God's awesome plan! We'll find out how we can do that in a few minutes.

Let's get started with a game called "Ships Across the Ocean."

	Game Title Slide: "Ships Across the Ocean"

You might have played a game like this one before, but you'll still want to listen to the rules. All of you are going to line up between two cones.

Do This: Point out the two cones.

When I say a color, anyone wearing that color must run to the other side and stand between the other two cones.

Do This: Point out the other two cones.

The catch is, there will be people in the middle trying to catch you! If you get tagged, you must sit down, right where you are. Then, you can try to tag other people running by, but you can't move. Ready to give it a try?

Do This: Select 1-5 people (depending on how many kids you have) to be taggers. You could have leaders start as the taggers for round one, and if you play a second round, choose a couple of the kids.



Fun Game Music!

Do This: Call out various colors, such as red, blue, green, yellow, white, gray, orange, and more! If someone is wearing that color, they have to run to the other side of the game area. If you get through one round quickly, you may play a second one with different people tagging in the middle.

That was fun! You can all come back and take a seat. We'll hear a story about someone who sailed in an actual ship across the ocean in a few minutes, but first, get ready to answer a question of the day!

(Auto Advance) QOTD Slide: What's something you've done that was difficult, but totally worth it?

What's something you've done that was difficult, but totally worth it? It could be something you practiced a ton, something you didn't think you'd like but you ended up loving it, or something you didn't think you could do but now you can. Go ahead and talk about that with the people around you, and listen to their answers, too!

Do This: Allow kids to talk for about 30 seconds.



Great answers, everyone. Sometimes the best thing we can do is just keep on trying, even if it's difficult.

Do This: Make sure each kid finds their group. Help group leaders if there is a need. Encourage kids as they work to answer the question.

Know This: This is a time for kids to search for answers in the Bible and see how they can use the Bible to investigate and better understand life. This time is designed for kids to interact and deepen their understanding. They won't get all the answers but allow them to question and discover as much as possible. Be ready to support group leaders in any way needed.

Do This: Give the groups a warning about one minute before this time is up.

I can do hard things with God by my side. You and I can do hard things with God by our side. No matter what we're facing, no matter how afraid or unsure we feel, God is with us. Maybe Rue or the Source team's story made you think about something in your own life. There's something difficult going on in your life, something you're worried about, or a "storm" you feel like you're in. The truth is, I don't know what you're going through. I can't tell you exactly what you should do about the tough things you're facing. Even though I don't know everything about your story, I do know that God loves you, and I know you can take another step forward with him by your side. Climbing Wall image

Imagine that some of the tough things in our lives are like this climbing wall. We all want to overcome those things, to get to the top of the wall, but how do we do that? Getting to the top of the wall feels great, but it isn't easy.

Do This: Take out four climbing wall stones.

The way we get to the top is to use the stones sticking out from the wall. Each one is another step on our journey to overcoming the wall. Now, if that's like a problem we're facing in life, each one of these is like a step God gives us to facing that hard thing.

Do This: Hold up each of the stones individually as you talk through the next four points.

Maybe that tough thing is being around someone who has been mean to you, maybe another kid at school. One step might be just asking them kindly to stop being mean. It might make a difference, but they also might not listen. Even if they don't listen to you, that's still a good step.

Another great step would be asking an adult, like your teacher or parents, for help and advice.

Another step might be choosing to forgive that person and deciding not to be mad at them. You could take that even further by telling them you forgive them.

Another step might be doing something kind for that person, even if they haven't been kind to you yet.

Whatever step you need to take, God is there with you. He's leading you, helping you, and He loves you. Sometimes, we don't know what's going to happen, but God always does. When He tells us to forgive, help others, and be kind, we can always trust that those are the right steps to take.



What if we're the ones who have been unkind to someone else? Even then, God is with you, and he can give you strength and courage to do the right things. You could take steps like saying you're sorry, admitting what you did wrong to an adult, and choosing to be kind to that person in the future.

The important thing is: Do you just use one step to climb a climbing wall? No! You use a whole bunch of them. Sometimes, when we have to do something tough, we try one
