Here's what I want you to remember today.



Your whole story matters.

Your whole story matters. Your life, everything you do and everything that happens to you, it's all part of your story, and it all matters. It can be hard to remember that, though. Sometimes we can feel like we want to change something about ourselves. We may want to fix a mistake we made or wish something bad wouldn't have happened to us. The truth is, though, all of those things matter.

Do This: Take out a roll of thread, unroll a bit, and show it to the kids.

I have some thread here. It's super tiny. It's probably hard to even see from where you are. When we look at all the things we do and the things that happen to us, sometimes they seem so small, like this thread, and we might wonder if they even matter. What I want you to know is that God cares about every thread. Everything that you go through, big or small, He is with you. Every one of those things is so important to Him.

Sometimes, we look at our lives, maybe a mistake we've made, or something bad that happened to us, and we wish we could change it, or even get rid of it. We wonder if God can really work through something so difficult. The truth is, God cares about those parts of our lives too. He takes every thread and weaves them together into something incredible. Take a look at this tapestry.

This tapestry didn't just happen by accident. Someone took millions of threads and wove them all together with a purpose and a plan. They took all the different threads, and turned them into an amazing work of art.

That is exactly what God is doing with your life. He takes every part of it, every moment, and is weaving them together to create something amazing. When you look at your life, your story, I hope you'll see how God is leading you and designing you for such a great purpose.

Even right now, your story can show others who God is. You can show others who God is and tell them about him by talking about what he has done in your life. If you're not sure what all this is about, or haven't decided to follow God yet, the best thing to do is talk to someone about it. Any of the leaders here would love to talk with you about God, and hear any questions you have.
