Lesson 1: Trailhead

Have you ever created something really special? A piece of art, a comic book, a Lego project, or an invention? When you create something, it matters to you. You take time to make it just the way you want it to be. This week, we'll explore what it means to be created by God and how that impacts our lives.

Lesson 2: In the Crew

We all want to be a part of a group. Sometimes we even try to change things about ourselves so that we can fit in with the people around us. This week we will hear about how Jesus accepted someone that most people rejected.

Lesson 3: A New Horizon

Life can be challenging. It can feel like we are on an adventure with mountains to climb, rivers to cross, and obstacles that get in our way. Sometimes we wonder if we really have what it takes to do the things God wants us to do. This week, we will discover how God showed a man named Moses that he was capable.

Lesson 4: Back on Track

Have you ever lost something that was valuable? When that happens, we do anything we can to find it! It is incredible to know that God thinks we are valuable – so valuable that he would do whatever it takes to be close to us.

Lesson 5: Outlook Point

A good attitude is amazing. It can turn something challenging into something fun. A bad attitude, though, can turn even the most fun things into frustrating, difficult, and boring ones. This week, we'll see how our attitudes can change the world around us.

Lesson 6: Long Way Home

Sometimes our mistakes and the wrong things we do make us feel like no one could ever love us. We might feel like we have to do all the right things so that we can earn God's love. This week, we'll hear the story of The Lost Son and learn more about the incredible love God has for each one of us!

Lesson 7: A Fork in the Trail

Sometimes, it's easy to believe our choices don't matter, that they don't affect anyone. This week, we'll hear how Ruth learned that her choices really do make a difference; and we'll see how our decisions can impact others today.

Lesson 8: Way-Words

Our words can be used to help or to hurt. In Ephesians, Paul challenges us to use words that build others up. We'll find out what that looks like this week!

Lesson 9: The Next Step

Daniel was in a new land with few friends. When others expected him to do things God says are wrong, Daniel had to choose whether to follow God or follow the people around him. This week, we'll discover the impact we can have when we stand up for what we believe.

Lesson 10: Backtracked

Imagine you've made a mistake. Something goes wrong, you mess up, but what happens next? Do you get angry? Give up? Blame someone else? Or could we see our mistakes in a different way? This week, we'll find out how our mistakes might even be a good thing.

Lesson 11: Which Way?

"Integrity" means doing what's right, even when no one is watching. This week, we'll hear how a man named Samuel chose integrity, even when others around him didn't.

Lesson 12: Into the Unknown

In the Bible, we see God tell people to be courageous, but it's not always for the reasons we'd expect. In Joshua's story, Joshua had to fight battles and lead a nation, but God said there was one thing he would do that would take even more courage than those things. We'll find out what it is this week!

Lesson 13: Onward!

King David's story doesn't start in a palace, it starts in a field. David was a shepherd, a musician, and a poet, and all of those were part of God's plan. As this new school year starts, we'll discover how everything we do is part of the way God designed us.



Series Title Slide: Trailblazers and clear audio

This is the last week of our series called "Trailblazers." We're on an expedition to learn more about ourselves and the amazing way God designed every one of us.

Let's get started with a game called "Group Pictionary."

Game Title Slide: "Group Pictionary"

I'm going to bring some groups of three of you up on the stage and give you a picture you need to copy here on stage. You have to become the people in the picture, which means you can't move! Everyone in the audience has to guess what is happening in that picture.



Fun Game Music!

First I'll pick some teams to play!

Do This: Pick 5 teams of three and have them come up on stage. Give each team something to act out.

Know This: The things to act out will be pictures, not words, in order to make it as easy as possible for kids to do this quickly. It's important that you give them the pictures in order. They will be numbered 1-5.

Know This: If you have fewer than 30 kids and taking 15 of them would make there be very few left in the audience, you can call up teams of three one at a time, and let the others stay in the audience to guess. Don't give teams their pictures to copy until they get on stage.

Ready? Let's go! First team, show us your picture!

Do This: Give positive commentary on their picture, such as "Wow, nice!" "This looks neat," or "Ooh, interesting." Listen to the audience to see if anyone guesses the right answer.

You had to be dinosaurs? That one was tough. Great job, though, you can sit back down.

I want to show you a verse from the Bible. It's something God said to his people a long

time ago.

Jeremiah 29:11- "I know the plans I have for you," announces the Lord. "I want you to enjoy success. I do not plan to harm you. I will give you hope for the years to come." Do This: Read the verse from the screen.
God was saying that to a group of people who followed him, but it's true for us today, too. God has a plan for you. He wants what's best for you. You may have heard this before, but a lot of people wonder "Ok, if God has a plan for me, what is it?"
That's a great question. The thing is, God's plan for you isn't just one thing. It's not just what school you're at, what your family is like, or who your friends are. It's all of those things. God knows and cares about every part of your life. It's kind of like this. Series Title Slide: Trailblazers
This series is called "Trailblazers" because life is like an adventure. We discover new things, meet people, and learn new skills, like we would while we are on a journey. And when we follow God, he's like our guide through our whole life.
Imagine if you went on a hike, to a place you'd never been, and you were all alone. What would probably happen? You might get lost, or hurt, or need help, and no one would be there. When you're exploring, it's wise to have a guide who knows that area.
Just like that, it's a wise choice to follow a guide through life. The only one who knows everything in our world, everything about us, and has an amazing plan for our lives is God!

That means God is the greatest guide for our lives. Following Him means doing what He says is right, seeing things the way He does, and loving others like He shows us how to. If you haven't made that decision to follow God, I would love to talk with you and tell you more about that amazing choice, and so would any of our volunteers.

1. Follow God as your guide.

So imagine, you have a guide, and you ask them: "What's the plan? Where are we going? How are we going to get there?" Do you think they'll stop walking, sit down, and spend a super long time telling you exactly how to get where you're going?

No! They'd probably just tell you a couple important things, like big landmarks to watch out for. We're going to follow a river, climb up a cliff, and get to a town at the end. So, if we want to know God's purpose for us, that means we need to watch for landmarks. 1. Follow God as your guide. 2. Watch for landmarks. There are signs in our lives that God is working, changing us, and leading us. One of the best places to learn what those are is in the Bible! **Do This:** Show kids a Bible. When we read the stories in the Bible, we can learn from the people in them, and we might be able to say "I've felt that way, too," or "That's like when this happened to me." There is also amazing wisdom in here. It tells us about the people God is helping us to become. He's helping us become people who care about others, who serve, and who know God super well. When we see those things in our lives, that's a landmark, a sign that God is helping us grow. There's a verse about this in the book of second Peter in the Bible. 2 Peter 1:6-8- To knowledge, add the ability to control yourselves. To the ability to control yourselves, add the strength to keep going. To the strength to keep going, add godliness. To godliness, add kindness for one another. And to kindness for one another, add love. All these things should describe you more and more. **Do This**: Read the verses from the screen. Notice what that says, the more we follow God, these things will describe us more and more. We will know more, we'll have more self-control, we'll be like God more, we'll

Notice what that says, the more we follow God, these things will describe us more and more. We will know more, we'll have more self-control, we'll be like God more, we'll be more kind, and more loving. All of those are signs that God is changing our lives! So, we can follow God as our guide, and watch for those landmarks in our lives, but there's one more thing we can do on this journey.

Finally, one of the best things we can do to find our purpose is trust God's big picture plan. Imagine, you're on a hike, you feel like you're almost there, and then you get to this spot.



That town is where you're headed, but what happens if you try to go straight there? You would fall! So what do you have to do? Well, there might be a trail, but you have to walk all the way around, down, and back to get to the town. Even though it looks super close, you might have a long way to go.

Sometimes, unexpected things like that happen in our lives, too. We make the team, but the coach makes us sit on the bench. We have amazing friends, but our parents decide that we're going to move to a new town. We feel like we've got it all figured out, then we make a mistake. When unexpected twists and turns happen, we need to trust God's big picture plan.



- 1. Follow God as your guide.
- 2. Watch for landmarks.
- 3. Trust God's big picture plan.

God still has a plan for you, whether you're doing great, or you feel like you've made a huge mistake. He is still with you, no matter how far from home you go.

So, the amazing thing is, we get to discover God's purpose every day! We get to learn about him, see how his peace, love, and kindness is growing in our lives, and watch for his big picture plan, every single day of our lives. God's purpose for us is this journey we're on right now.

The trailblazing team is going to share a story of someone who learned that, but first, let's get moving with a challenge from our challenge wheel!
