



Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: Group Pictionary Cards.

1. Time to Talk

Discussion Questions:

- What is something good you've been given?
- Why do you think that verse Dan read said to be "rich in doing good things"? (Point out that the verse is saying doing what is right and living for God is even better than having lots of money.)
- What are the two "values" the clues have been about so far? (Follow Jesus and Live Generously). What do you think those things mean?
- What are some ways we could be "generous" to others? (Give some of what we have to help others, do good things for others, take time to serve.)

Ask: What is coming up this summer that you are excited about? Is there anything you would like God's help with right now?

Pray: Talk to God, mentioning relevant things that came up in your discussion.

2. Activity: Group Pictionary

Say This: Dan and Dr. Eulav had to work together to get through that obstacle! Does anyone remember what value they were using? (Connect in Community). In this activity, we have to work together too. This activity is called "Group Pictionary." I'm going to give you each a piece of a picture. You cannot show the picture to anyone else, but you can talk about it. Our job is to figure out what the picture is of!

Do This: Give each kid a piece of a picture and try to work out what the picture is by communicating together! Try this for each of the pictures provided.

Know This: The pictures will be divided into 10 parts. If you have a large group of kids, give each section of the picture to a group of two or more kids.

The Point: When we work together, we can see things that we wouldn't on our own. I think Dan and Dr. Eulav learned that too!
