Lesson 1: Start with Me

Have you ever been upset with a friend or sibling? It is easy for us to see what they did wrong, but how often do we pause to think about what we could have done differently? This week we'll see how our relationships can improve when we focus on our part.

Lesson 2: Tension in the Air

What can we do when someone is mean or hurts our feelings? Do we hurt them back or is there a better way? This week, we'll discover what Jesus has to say about resolving conflict.

Lesson 3: Won't You Be My Neighbor?

Jesus talks about loving our neighbors, but who is my neighbor? Is it just the person living next door to me or is it someone else? This week, we'll hear a story that Jesus tells to help us understand who our neighbor is and how we should treat them.

Lesson 4: Enemy Territory

We all have people in our lives that are difficult to love. Maybe they have been mean to us or they just bother us. This week, we'll take a look at Jesus' challenge to "love your enemies."

Lesson 5: The Greatest of All Time

Have you ever had an argument with a friend or sibling about who is the best or most important? Jesus' disciples argued about the same thing. This week, we'll find out how Jesus answers them and what he says will make us great.

Lesson 6: A Matter of the Heart

How do the things we watch and listen to affect our heart? This week, we'll talk about the importance of what goes in our heart and how it can impact our relationships.

Lesson 7: A Love Like No Other

Sometimes our relationships can leave us feeling disappointed. Family or friends can let us down, but there is one relationship that we can always count on. This week, we'll hear a story Jesus tells about a man who runs away from home and the father who loved him.

Lesson 8: Forgiveness Factor

What does it take to have peace in our relationships? We try to get along, but sometimes things get messy and someone gets their feelings hurt. This week, we'll discover the importance of forgiveness and how it can impact our relationships.

Welcome everyone! I'm so glad you're all here! Come on up and find a place to sit.




My name is _____, and I'm so excited to be here with all of you! We've got some great things coming up. We'll get to sing, hear some great stories, and play some fun games, too.

We're in a series about relationships called "When Life Gets Messy." God made each one of us to be in relationships, but sometimes those relationships can feel a little bit messy. 

Jesus loves each one of you just the way you are, even if your life has been a little messy. He wants to be your friend and the leader in your life. Some of you have already made the decision to follow Jesus and that's amazing! Your journey has already started. But choosing to follow Jesus is a life-long journey, and there are still next steps you can take to grow closer to Him. That's what this boot reminds me of.

Do This: Hold up the boot.

You can take steps like serving others, reading your Bible, or sharing Jesus' story. Those are all great steps to take to continue your journey with Jesus!

Do This: Set the boot aside.

Maybe you are someone who still has some questions and that is okay! Your questions are so important. Following Jesus isn't a choice that your parents or friends can make for you, it is an important choice that only you can make. If you have questions, I want to encourage you to talk to someone, like any of the leaders here at church. I will also be up on stage at the end of the hour and would love to talk about any questions you have. That's what this walkie-talkie reminds me of.

Do This: Hold up the walkie-talkie.

Maybe today is your day and you feel ready to make the decision to follow Jesus and make him the leader in your life. This compass reminds me of that.

Do This: Hold up the compass.

Jesus is the greatest leader and guide you could ever have. He can guide you through life just like this compass can guide you through the wilderness. In a moment, we're going to talk to God. If you are ready to make the decision to follow Jesus, you can talk to God with me. You'll tell God that you know you've done wrong things, you're sorry, that you want to follow Jesus, and that you want him to be the leader in your life. You can say these words out loud or in your mind, God hears you either way. Let's all close our eyes so we aren't distracted by the people around us.

Do This: Read the following prayer word for word, giving enough time after each line for the kids to repeat after you, even if they are doing it silently.
