Lesson 1: Dizzying Times

Some days feel like everything is changing. You might not understand a lesson, have an argument with your best friend, or even move to a new place. The great news is, whatever happens, God will always have a plan for you, and He will always be the same. This week, we'll find out how a man named Daniel trusted God, even through a difficult time.

Lesson 2: Singled Out

Step onto the stage, the spotlight is on you! What do you do? Sometimes, choosing what God says is right will mean living differently from others. This week, we'll see that following God is worth it, even when it means standing out.

Lesson 3: Brain Games

How does your mind work? Do you prefer reading a book, or watching a movie? Would you rather write a story, or tell a story out loud? Every person's mind is different, but God designed them all! This week, we'll hear how Daniel helped a king with some confusing problems, and see that however your mind works, God made it for a reason!

Lesson 4: Partner Up

Some obstacles can't be conquered alone. Who do you have on your team? Sometimes friends, family, and other people can help us, but there is only one who will always be there, wherever you are. This week, we'll see how God can help us when our problems seem too big to handle alone.

Lesson 5: The Champion

This week, we'll hear how God's Son, Jesus, overcame every obstacle to give us the chance to have a relationship with God. He is the greatest example of how to live, and the one we can trust with our lives, because He gave His life for us.

Lesson 6: Which Way?

When you face an important choice, how do you decide which way is right? For Daniel, that decision was simple, because he trusted God's way, no matter what. We can trust God in the same way today!

Series Title Slide: Wipe Out

Sometimes, life feels like an obstacle course. We face new challenges every day, but when life gets tough, the people we are with make all the difference in the world. That's what we're talking about today. Who is on your team? Not exactly your soccer or basketball team, but who is on your life team? Who helps you when you need it? Who listens to you, and gives you advice?

Today, we're going to hear about people who had to decide who was on their team, see what they did, play some games, and get to learn more about God, and why He made us to do life together. Let's get started with an activity called "On My Side."

Game Title Slide: On My Side (and clear audio)

Each of your group leaders has a tarp or a blanket. You'll stand on that tarp, and then they'll tell you what your challenge is. Ready?

Do This: Make sure group leaders know what activity to do with their team. 1-3rd graders will be trying to move the tarp down to a cone and back to their starting line, without stepping off of it. They will need a line of masking tape to start at, and a cone set about 15-20 feet away. 4-

5th graders will be challenged to turn over their tarp, again without anyone stepping off of it. For 4-5th grade, if anyone steps off of the tarp, you could have them lose a leg, or just have to sit on the tarp from that point on. If groups finish early enough, group leaders can encourage them to try again, and beat their time.

Know This: If you are in a 1-3rd or 4-5th only space, feel free to explain the activity from the stage. If you are in a combined space, let group leaders explain their group's activity, to avoid confusion.

Alright, you can head over to your group flag! Your leaders will tell you what your challenge is from there. In about a minute, I'll start a countdown!

Do This: When you see all the kids standing on their tarps, start the countdown.

You have five minutes, ready, set, go!

(Auto Advance) Challenge Wheel Slide: Meet someone born in the same month as you!

Do This: Give kids a minute to find someone born in the same month as them. Feel free to search for someone born in the same month as you, too! Once a minute is up, call them back.

Big Idea Slide: "I can trust that God will never leave my side."

I can trust that God will never leave my side. What an amazing promise! God is with you, even if you don't feel like it. Even if everything goes wrong, even if you've done <u>something</u> wrong, you can turn to God, and He is already there, and already loves you.

Series Title Slide: Wipe Out

We can always trust that God will be there for us, and that's the start of the best team ever. God is the most important one to trust, and to have on your team, but He also knows that having other people on our team is important. Your group leaders are going to hand you a piece of paper and a marker, and I want you to write a couple things.

Do This: Make sure every kid gets a "Team Builder" handout and a marker.

Think about the people you trust, the people that have been there for you. They could be someone in your family, or just someone you trust. Write down one or two people that you are glad to have on your team.

Do This: Give kids a minute to write someone down. While they write, fill out this page with them, and tell them who you are writing about, and why.

Great! God can put people in our lives to help us, lead us, and give us good advice. The people you choose to be on your team are important. Over this next week, think more about the people you trust, the people you want to be on your team. If there's

something you need help with, talk to someone you can trust, a parent, a teacher, someone who is on your team.

It's great to have a team who is there for you. In that last space, though, write down someone you want to be there for. Someone you could be a friend to. Write down their name and think about what you could do to be a friend to them this week. Being there for someone can make a big difference in their life.

Do This: Give kids a minute or so to write someone down.

You can write more down later this week, if you haven't finished, that's totally ok. Right now, though, let's stand, and get ready to worship God!
