Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: Character cards.

1. Getting Started

Ask: If you could make up a new Olympic sport, what would it be?

2. Discussion Questions

- What could happen if Trixie and Jesse are mean back to Samantha? What other choices do they have?
- What's something someone has done for you that made you feel honored, like you were very important?
- Have you ever honored someone else? How?

3. Hands-On Option

Look Up and Read: Romans 12:10. This verse is about “honoring” others or showing that they are important and valuable. Another version of the verse is: “Outdo one another in showing honor.”

Say This: To honor someone means to respect them, to say or show why they are important and valuable.

Do This: Read each of the character cards and talk about ways you could “honor” that person. Some ideas are given on each card.

Discuss: How could we honor people in our own lives, like our friends or families?

The Point: When we start looking for ways to honor others, we'll start to see so much that is good in other people. We might start to understand better why God loves every person in the world! When our words and actions honor others, we'll also make a difference in their lives. Every one of us can honor others!

4. Wrap-Up and Prayer

Ask: What's something you're excited about right now? What's something you would like God's help with?

Do This: Pray with the kids. If they've mentioned things that would be good to talk to God about, you can mention them in your prayer.
