Series at a Glance for Kid-O-Deo (continued)

Lesson 1: Jesus obeyed

Did you know Jesus was a kid once, too? He even made His grown-ups worried sometimes. When Jesus' grown-ups told him to do something, though, he listened. We can make the wise choice and obey our grown-ups today, too!

Lesson 2: Jesus prayed

Jesus talked to God a lot! He talked to God when He felt afraid, when He was doing well, and when He felt hurt. Jesus knew that God cares about us, no matter where we are or what is going on. We can talk to God like Jesus did!

Lesson 3: Jesus served others

Jesus was God's son, but he didn't come to be in charge. Instead, He came to serve people, and show how much God loves them. When we choose to serve others, we're following Jesus' example!

Lesson 4: Jesus used wise words

Did you know your words are super powerful? They can make people feel hurt or make them feel great. Jesus used wise words to help and encourage others, and we can, too.

Lesson 5: Jesus was kind

When Jesus met someone who others had been mean and unkind to, Jesus showed that he cared. Jesus' kindness changed their life, and when we are kind like he was, we can make a big difference, too!

Lesson 6: Jesus knew God was in control

While sailing one day, Jesus and his disciples ended up in the middle of a storm! The disciples panicked, but Jesus took the chance to show them something important. No matter how bad things are, we can always trust God.

Lesson 7: Jesus gave his life for me

Jesus did so many amazing things, but the greatest of all was something he did for you! Jesus gave his life, so every one of us can have a relationship with God. That's why we follow Jesus and live the way he did, he showed every one of us how much God loves us.

Introduction and Rules

We want this to be a great place for all you leaders and Kid-Os, which means no poking, kicking, or bugging your neighbor. A good way to remember this rule is to: do a little clap and place your hands in your lap!

Rule #3: Stay in your spot!

You have a spot of your very own here in Kid-O-Deo, and it's right where you are sitting! It's important for us to stay in our spots, so that everyone can pay attention and have fun!

Next we get to sing about God! This song is about how amazing Jesus is!


Song 1: Better Than the Best Thing

(Auto advance) Series Title Slide: Whoo's Wise?

Big Idea 2:00

I love singing with you, Kid-Os! You can sit down. We're in a series called "Whoo's Wise?" that is all about making wise choices. We'll be looking at wise things that God's Son Jesus did a long time ago and talking about wise choices we can make today.

Next we've got a "Big Idea" to learn! Our Big Idea is a super important idea that we're learning about today. Let's practice saying it together.



The big idea is "Talking to God helps me be wise." Can you repeat that after me? The Big Idea. THE BIG IDEA. Talking to God, TALKING TO GOD, helps me, HELPS ME, be wise. BE WISE.

Do This: Show Kid-Os the actions and have them practice the Big Idea with you three times. Use a different voice each time. **Voice ideas for this week: Flying bird, bubbling fish, stomping dinosaur.**

Know This: These are the Big Idea actions: (Make a rainbow motion with your hands) The Big Idea. (Fold hands) talking to God (point to self) helps me (point to forehead) be wise.

Awesome job practicing our Big Idea, Kid-Os! You can all sit down.

While we learn today, Ollie the wise owl is going to remind us to practice our big idea! Whenever you hear Ollie hoot, that means we need to say our big idea! I wonder if he's nearby now.

There's Ollie's hoot! Let's say the big idea one more time, all together.

Do This: Show kids the Bible.

The Bible is the greatest book ever. It's full of words from God, and there are lots of true stories about people who loved God in the Bible too! Today we get to hear a story about God's son, Iesus.

Do This: Get the Bible storybook out and sit down in the chair.

This story you are going to hear comes from the Bible, but we use this storybook because the pictures help us imagine what it might have looked like back when the Bible was written. The pictures you see in here are the same as the ones on the screen. Let's get started!

Do This: Have kids help you "turn" the pages on the screen with an exaggerated arm wave.




Picture 1: Jesus teaching on a hill

One day Jesus was teaching a lot of people. They wanted to know how to talk to God. esus gave them an example by praying right then.	
Picture 2: Jesus praying	
esus started praying by saying how amazing God is. Then he asked God to help and protect everyone there. He prayed that they would be forgiven for the wrong things they had done, and asked God to help them make right choices.	
Picture 3: Jesus in the temple by praying person	
esus met lots of people who talked to God in lots of different ways. He told people that praying wasn't about saying just the right words or sounding smart. Jesus said praying was about spending time with God, telling him about our lives, saying thank you to him, and asking him for help.	
Picture 4: Jesus alone	
esus spent a lot of time praying, even when he was very busy. Jesus made time to calk to God whenever he could, whether it was in the morning, afternoon, and at night. He knew that talking to God helped him make wise choices.
