Lesson 1: Jesus obeyed

Did you know Jesus was a kid once, too? He even made His grown-ups worried sometimes. When Jesus' grown-ups told him to do something, though, he listened. We can make the wise choice and obey our grown-ups today, too!

Lesson 2: Jesus prayed

Jesus talked to God a lot! He talked to God when He felt afraid, when He was doing well, and when He felt hurt. Jesus knew that God cares about us, no matter where we are or what is going on. We can talk to God like Jesus did!

Lesson 3: Jesus served others

Jesus was God's son, but he didn't come to be in charge. Instead, He came to serve people, and show how much God loves them. When we choose to serve others, we're following Jesus' example!

Lesson 4: Jesus used wise words

Did you know your words are super powerful? They can make people feel hurt or make them feel great. Jesus used wise words to help and encourage others, and we can, too.

Lesson 5: Jesus was kind

When Jesus met someone who others had been mean and unkind to, Jesus showed that he cared. Jesus' kindness changed their life, and when we are kind like he was, we can make a big difference, too!

Lesson 6: Jesus knew God was in control

While sailing one day, Jesus and his disciples ended up in the middle of a storm! The disciples panicked, but Jesus took the chance to show them something important. No matter how bad things are, we can always trust God.

Lesson 7: Jesus gave his life for me

Jesus did so many amazing things, but the greatest of all was something he did for you! Jesus gave his life, so every one of us can have a relationship with God. That's why we follow Jesus and live the way he did, he showed every one of us how much God loves us.

Introduction and Rules

Welcome everyone! My name is _____, and I'm so glad every one of you is here! Today we get to sing some songs, hear an amazing story, and learn about our awesome God! Before we get started, let's remember our three Kid-O-Deo rules!

Know This: This is a great opportunity to set the tone and expectations for your time together. Kids like to know what's expected of them too—it helps them feel safe and secure. You can make this section informative, helpful, and fun all at the same time!

Rule #1: When I'm talking you are listening!

Let's put on our listening ears and turn them way up! We'll also turn our voices way down, so that we can all listen super well.

Rule #2: Keep your hands and feet to yourself!

We want this to be a great place for all you leaders and Kid-Os, which means no poking, kicking, or bugging your neighbor. A good way to remember this rule is to: do a little clap and place your hands in your lap!

Rule #3: Stay in your spot!

You have a spot of your very own here in Kid-O-Deo, and it's right where you are sitting! It's important for us to stay in our spots, so that everyone can pay attention and have fun!

I love singing with you, Kid-Os! You can sit down. Right now, we're in a series called "Whoo's Wise?" that is all about making wise choices. We'll be looking at wise things that God's Son Jesus did a long time ago and talking about wise choices we can make today.

Next we've got a "Big Idea" to learn! The Big Idea is a super important idea that we'll be learning about today. Let's practice saying it together!

Big Idea Jingle

(Auto advance) Big Idea Slide: Trusting God is a wise choice.

The big idea is "Trusting God is a wise choice." Can you repeat that after me? The Big Idea. THE BIG IDEA. Trusting God TRUSTING GOD is a wise choice. IS A WISE CHOICE.

Do This: Show Kid-Os the actions and have them practice the Big Idea with you three times. Use a different voice each time. **Voice ideas for this week: Chirping bird, zooming snowmobile, and slow turtle.** **Know This**: These are the Big Idea actions: (Make a rainbow motion with your hands) The Big Idea. (Hold one hand out, palm up, place your other fist into your palm.) Trusting God (point to your head) is a wise choice.

Awesome job practicing our Big Idea, Kid-Os! You can all sit down.

While we learn today, Ollie the wise owl is going to remind us to practice our big idea! Whenever you hear Ollie hoot, that means we need to say our big idea! I wonder if he's nearby now.

There's Ollie's hoot! Let's say the big idea one more time, all together.

Bible Adventure

Now we know that trusting God is a wise choice, but what does it mean to trust God? To find out, we get to go on a Bible Adventure!

Bible Adventure Jingle

Do This: Show kids the Bible.

The Bible is the greatest book ever. It's full of words from God, and there are lots of true stories about people who loved God in the Bible too! Today we get to hear a story about a time Jesus did something amazing.

Do This: Get the Bible storybook out and sit down in the chair.

This story you are going to hear comes from the Bible, but we use this storybook because the pictures help us imagine what it might have looked like back when the Bible was written. The pictures you see in here are the same as the ones on the screen. Let's get started!

Do This: Have kids help you "turn" the pages on the screen with an exaggerated arm wave.



Picture 1: Disciples in a boat

Jesus and his friends, the disciples were sailing across a sea called the "Sea of Galilee." While they were sailing, a huge storm started! Can you make a "boom" sound like thunder? BOOM!



Picture 2: Boat in a storm

The disciples were super afraid! Huge waves were all around them, and they thought the boat might sink! Then, they realized something strange. Jesus wasn't worried at all. In fact, Jesus was sleeping!



Picture 3: Jesus calms the storm

The disciples woke Jesus up, and said "Don't you care if we drown?" Jesus wasn't afraid of the storm, though. He knew God was in control. Jesus stood up and talked to the storm. He said "Quiet! Be still."



Picture 4: The storm is quiet

Right away, the storm stopped. The waves were still, and there was no more wind. Jesus had stopped the storm! Jesus asked the disciples: "Why were you afraid?" Jesus knew he didn't have to be afraid, because God was in control of everything, even of a storm.

Great listening, Kid-Os! What an amazing story. God is still in control today, just like he was when Jesus was on earth. We can always trust Him!

(Auto-advance) Memory Verse: John 13:34- "Love one another. You must love one another, just as I have loved you."

Our Memory Verses here in Kid-O-Deo come from the Bible. This verse is something Jesus said.

Do This: Read the verse from the screen.

Jesus wants us to make wise choices, and he made so many wise choices while he was on earth, too. In this verse, Jesus is telling us to love other people like he did. That is such a wise choice! Let's practice saying this verse together.

Do This: Practice the verse with the Kid-Os three times. You can start in your quiet/whisper voice and then get a little louder each time you practice.

Know This: The verse with actions goes like this: (Open your Bibles) John 13:34- (Point to different people in the crowd) Love one another. (Cross arms across chest) You must love one another, (point up) just as I have loved you.
