Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: Two hearts made out of tissue paper.

1. Introductions and Snack

Circle Up: As you come into the room, have Kid-Os say “hi” to someone else in the circle as they sit down. Encourage each Kid-O to say their name.

Do This: Give kids hand sanitizer, then hand each of them a snack.

2. Discussion Questions

- Who was Jesus kind to in our Bible Adventure story? (The Samaritan woman.)
- What are some kind things for people to do? (Help, say kind things, give someone a turn.)

Repeatable Phrases: *“I can be wise.” “I can be kind.”*

3. Hands-On Option

Say This: Being kind is so important! Kind words and actions make a big difference. For this first heart, let’s pass it around and be very kind and gentle to it.

Do This: Pass around the heart, being gentle and trying not to tear it.

Say This: For this second heart, crumple it when you pass it around.

Do This: Pass around the second heart, letting each Kid-O hold it. Show both hearts.

The Point: We were rough to the second heart, and you can see it made a difference. When our words are rough and unkind, they can hurt others. When we are kind and gentle, we can make others feel good!

4. Big Idea, Memory Verse, Stickers, and Prayer

Do This: Practice the Big Idea and Memory Verse with the kids.

Memory Verse: John 13:34- Love one another. You must love one another, just as I have loved you.

Big Idea: Being kind is a wise choice.

Big Idea: Give each kid a sticker. Encourage them to talk about what they learned with their grown-ups.

Do This: Pray! “Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to be kind to others. Amen.”
