

Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: Gospel story pictures.

1. Introductions and Snack

Circle Up: Have Kid-Os sit down in a circle as quickly as they can and give you a "thumbs up" when they are ready to listen. Encourage each Kid-O to say their name.

Do This: Give kids hand sanitizer, then hand each of them a snack.

2. Discussion Questions

- What did we learn that Jesus did in our Bible story? (Died and came back to life.)
- Who was Jesus? (God's son.)

Repeatable Phrases: "Jesus loves me." "I can trust Jesus."

3. Hands-On Option

Do This: Show Kid-Os all the story images, and talk about what order the story goes in. The story will match the Bible Adventure. Allow the Kid-Os to tell you which image goes first, second, and so on. Review the story with them as you arrange the pictures.

The Point: Jesus' story is so important for every one of us! He died and came back to life so we can know how much God loves us.

4. Big Idea, Memory Verse, Stickers, and Prayer

Do This: Practice the Big Idea and Memory Verse with the kids.

Memory Verse: John 13:34- Love one another. You must love one another, just as I have loved you.

Big Idea: I can follow Jesus.

Do This: Give each kid a sticker. Encourage them to talk about what they learned with their grown-ups.

Do This: Pray! "Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to follow you every day. Amen.
