

# **Group Time Guide**

Supplies Needed: Two hearts made out of tissue paper.

#### 1. Introductions and Snack

**Circle Up:** As you come into the room, have Kid-Os say "hi" to someone else in the circle as they sit down. Encourage each Kid-O to say their name.

**Do This**: Give kids hand sanitizer, then hand each of them a snack.

#### 2. Discussion Questions

- Who was Jesus kind to in our Bible Adventure story? (The Samaritan woman.)
- What are some kind things for people to do? (Help, say kind things, give someone a turn.)

## 3. Hands-On Option

**Say This**: Being kind is so important! Kind words and actions make a big difference. For this first heart, let's pass it around and be very kind and gentle to it.

Do This: Pass around the heart, being gentle and trying not to tear it.

**Say This**: For this second heart, crumple it when you pass it around.

**Do This**: Pass around the second heart, letting each person crumple it. Show kids both hearts.

**The Point**: We were rough to the second heart, and you can see it made a difference. When our words are rough and unkind, they can hurt others. When we are kind and gentle, we can make others feel good!

### 4. Big Idea, Memory Verse, Stickers, and Prayer

**Do This**: Practice the Big Idea and Memory Verse with the kids.

**Memory Verse**: John 13:34- Love one another. You must love one another, just as I have loved you.

Big Idea: Being kind is a wise choice.

**Big Idea**: Give each kid a sticker. Encourage them to talk about what they learned with their grown-ups.

**Do This**: Pray! "Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to be kind to others. Amen.
